Supplement to Complaint for Revocation of License

CAMELOT SHOW LOUNGE 2714 S. 13th Street Milwaukee, Wisconsin

Comes now, T. Anthony Zielinski ("Complainant"), being first duly sworn and upon his oath who respectfully shows and alleges as follows:

- Complainant is an adult resident of the City and County of Milwaukee, Wisconsin residing at 2463 South Superior Street.
- 2. Complainant is the Representative for the 14th Aldermanic District in the City of Milwaukee, Wisconsin.
- 3. That Terry J. Cullen (Licensee) of Camelot Show Lounge is the holder of a Class "B" Tavern and an Amusement Cabaret License for the premises located at 2714 S. 13th Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin.
- 4. That on October 18, 2007, Milwaukee Police officers and Wisconsin State Department of Revenue Agents conducted a tavern check at Camelot Show Lounge located at 2714 S. 13th Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin. Three dancers were exposing the areola and the nipple of their breasts to patrons and were cited for "Certain Costumes Prohibited," in violation of the Milwaukee City Ordinances 90-22-1b and 90-22-1c. One of the dancers also pulled her "G-string" underwear to the side exposing her vagina then "touched" herself. A dancer was arrested for a felony Violation of Probation warrant and

for several retail theft warrants. A man was also arrested for an outstanding Violation of Probation Felony warrant. The Wisconsin State Department of Revenue Alcohol & Tobacco Enforcement Unit Agents inspected the Camelot's alcohol invoices and found un-invoiced alcohol, in violation of state law. They found 1 contaminated alcohol bottle. The agents seized 40 bottles of alcohol and a case of beer due to un-invoiced alcohol.

- 5. That on October 16, 2007, Milwaukee Police officers conducted an undercover investigation to investigate complaints of prostitution by dancers/strippers employed at the Camelot Show Lounge, located at 2714 S. 13th Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin. A dancer approached the undercover investigation and performed body gyrations on him. The dancer also grabbed his groin area 3-4 times. The dancer had nothing covering her nipple and areola of her breasts and her "thong" underpants did not cover the cleavage of The dancer also stuck out her pierced tongue and wiggled it at the undercover officer. The dancer then pulled down the side of her underpants, exposing her vagina to the officer's view, and began stroking it while wiggling her tongue at him. The dancer told the officer," Yeah we can hang out, it will cost you \$100.00 for me, and I don't do anal." After her performance, the dancer handed the officer a cocktail napkin with her telephone number on it. That same day, the officer contacted the dancer and arranged to meet with the dancer at another bar. When the officer and the dancer met at the bar, the dancer requested the \$100.00 and put it in her left pant pocket. The dancer was subsequently arrested for prostitution.
- 6. Wherefore, your Complainant prays that the Class "B" Tavern Licenses for the Club)

 premises at 2714 South 13th Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin, Camelot Show Lounge, be revoked.

This report is written by P.O. Evelyn LAZO, assigned to District 2, Early Shift. We received information that the dancers at the Carnelot located at 2714 S. 13th Street were requesting to commit an act of sexual contact for money with the patrons. We were also informed that these dancers were also exposing their areola, the nipple of thier breast, their vagina and buttocks to the patrons. We were also informed that underage patrons were allowed in the tavern without checking for identification and being sold alcohol.

On Thursday, 10/18/07 at 2:00PM we conducted a tevern investigation at the Camelot Show Lounge. Police Aide Adam LUEBBE who is underage (20 years old) entered the tavern at approx. 2:23PM, in plain clothes. P.A. LUEBBE was not carded and was able to purchase a can of Miller Lite for \$3.00 from the bartender who was later identified as Amy B. STUBING (W/F, 02/24/75). P.A. LUEBBE stated that when he entered the bar one of the dancers who was later identified as Sheena M. BROOKS (B/F 10/02/84 of 3421 W. Kilbourn Ave) was dancing at the bar stage area which is located on the west/north corner of the bar. P.A. LUEBBE stated that BROOKS untiled her top portion of her costume (halter carni top w/matching bik G-string underware) exposing her areola and nipple area of both breast.

P.O. Michael SLOMCZEWSKI entered the tavem at 2:28PM and sat with P.A. LUEBBE at the bar and purchased a can of Bud Lite for \$3.00. P.A. LUEBBE and P.O. SLOMCZEWSKI stated that as they were sitted at the bar another dancer who was later identified as FleurChantal BOYD (W/F, 09/13/80 of 5216 N. 53rd Street, phone 610-9773) got on stage. P.A. LUEBBE and P.O. SLOMCZEWSKI stated that BOYD worked her way onto the bar. They stated that BOYD untied the front top portion of her costume (black short top with a single tie in front and matching G-string underware) exposing her areola and nipple area of both breast. P.A. LUEBBE and P.O. SLOMCZEWSKI stated that BOYD later came back on stage and walk onto the bar. They stated that BOYD pulled her G-String underware to the side exposing her vagina and touched herself.

A few minutes later Nicole L. CHURCHVILLE (B/F, 08/21/79 of 2429 N. Gordon Place #4, phone # 380-4411) came on stage and performed. P.A. LUEBBE and P.O. SLOMCZEWSKI stated that she also untiled the top portion of her costume (white knitted bikini top w/matching G-string underware) and exposed her areola and nipple area of both breast.

An inspector of the Department of Neighborhood Services also responded to inspect the building and found plumbing problems and advised STUBING.

Special Agent Henry MOREL and Georgeann KING from Department of Revenue Alcohol & Tobacco Enforcement Unit inspected the invoices and found uninvoiced alcohol. They found 1 contaminated alcohol bottle. Forty bottles of alcohol, a 12 pack of Budweiser and a 12 pack of Beck's Dark were consfiscated due to uninvoiced alcohol.

BOYD was arrested for a felony VOP and several retail theft warrants. A patron later identified as Keith C. KRAUSE (W/M, 09-19-67 of 2836 S. 15th Street phone 840-2621) was also arrested due to a felony VOP.

I spoke to the licensee by phone, he stated that he was in IL for the weekend and could not meet with me regarding the violations that were observed until Monday or Tuesday.

TOMMY'S AND CAMELOT HOUSE RULES

DRINKS - all drinks are FULL PRICE. Soda and juice are free of charge. Food must be eaten in the dressing room ONLY.

DRUNK AND DISORDERLY - if our drinking becomes a problem, we reserve the right to cut you off, if you become disorderly, you will be asked to leave. If you are underage and are caught drinking, you will be sent home and dismissed. Any employee caught bringing liquor into this bar will be immediately dismissed

FOOTWEAR AND STAGE CARE - you can dance bare footed, however you MUST have some type of shoe on at all times when you are walking around the bar. The HEALTH CODE requires you to have footwear on. Clothing must be off the stage at the end of each shift.

MIRRORS - must be cleaned throughout each shift, and at the end of each shift or the last dancer of that shift will be reprimanded.

DRUGS - what you do in your personal life is your business; HOWEVER what you do on the CAMELOT-TOMMY'S premises is the business of CAMELOT AND TOMMY'S. If you buy, sell, use or pass drugs while on the premises of either the CAMELOT or TOMMY'S you will be immediately dismissed.

FRIENDS AND EX-EMPLOYEES – are NOT allowed in the dressing room. NO EXCEPTIONS. Auditions are to dress in the ladies room.

STAGE CONDUCT - you must have al 2 of your songs punched in and ready to go on stage when the dancer before you is done. Dead air is when people leave. You have 2 songs to walk the bar unless it is very busy. If people want to talk to you tell them you'll be right back after you walk. DANCERS ARE NOT ALLOWED BEHIND THE BAR. except to get to the stage at CAMELOT.

PARTIES - we do not get involved with your party business and will not discourage you from doing parties - HOWEVER - you are not allowed to call in sick, leave early, or come in late because you have a party to do. PLEASE remember that your behavior at parties may affect the reputation of TOMMY'S AND CAMELOT.

PRIVATE SHOWS (e.g. one on one) could be considered prostitution. Be careful, these shows could also be dangerous to your safety. If you choose to do these, please keep the information to yourself.

PROSTITUTION - the sale or trade of sexual favors for money or other good and valuable considerations is called prostitution. It is against house rules, and against the law. If it is suspected that you are using the Camelot or Tommy's to acquire customers for sexual service business, we will dismiss you immediately. You may not ask a customer for a tip or a table dance. In the form of a question it is considered solicitation. However, you may say, "let me know if you would like a table dance"

BOYFRIENDS AND HUSBANDS - are NOT allowed in the bar during business hours. Dancers are never allowed to leave with the CUSTOMERS. No matter how innocent it may be. Security Personnel MUST walk all dancers to their vehicles when they leave.

DRESSING ROOMS - must be kept clean during the dancers shift. The Security will check each night at the end of the shift to see if the dressing room is clean. If the room is not cleaned each dancer will have a 10.00 fee if not cleaned.

ONLY I DANCER ON THE STAGE AT A TIME. THERE IS NO GRAND FINALE.

Dancers can not sit on the customers lap including private dances.

Dancers do not run the bar - if they do - don't listen to them. They will either get fined or dismissed.

Dancers must have their ID'S with them. And must be driver's license or state id only is accepted.

Dancers are not to get drunk. If they are then the bartender will stop serving them.

FEES ARE THE FOLLOWING:

Dressing room fee - 5.00 (except for Camelot) Late - first 1/2 hr - 10.00 - after first 1/2 hr. it is 15.00 Taking tips in the front and the back - 10.00 Smoking in basement - 10.00 Solicitation -- dismissed
