#### Dear Council Members:

Returned herewith is a document filed by Attorney Laurie Eggert for attorney's fees for representing Police Officers John Miller, Kevin Dudley and Jay Grant. The claim is in the amount of \$2,056.15 including \$21.15 in disbursements for 18.50 hours of service billed at the rate of \$110.00 per hour. We ask that this matter be introduced and referred to the Committee on Judiciary & Legislation.

We have reviewed this claim and advise that in our opinion, the time spent was reasonable. Legal representation was occasioned by a criminal investigation. No criminal charges were brought against the Police Officers on whose behalf this claim was filed.

As we have advised you under similar circumstances in the past, the Common Council has discretion to reject this claim or to pay it in whole or in part. Sec. 895.35, Stats., *Bablitch and Bablitch v. Lincoln County*, 82 Wis. 2d 574 (1978).

The above-named police officers have retained us to represent them in connection with the above-referenced matter.

Consistent with its policy, the City Attorney's Office has refused to represent them, and as they were performing the duties of their office at the time of the events giving rise to the incident, the claim is hereby made on their behalf for the indicated legal fees. This incident involved two allegations by Mr. Viverette after he was arrested on a warrant.

The MPD initiated a criminal investigation in which the officers initially declined to give a statement without counsel. When they requested counsel, IAD compelled POs Miller, Dudley and Grant to give a statement concerning the incident after issuing a PI-21.

Later, the MPD decided not to issue criminal charges against the officers. Attached is an itemization of the time and services rendered.

This report was dictated by Lieutenant of Detectives Mary Hoerig, of the Criminal Investigation Unit/Internal Affairs Division (CIU/IAD), Early Shift.

#### **ALLEGATION:**

The complainant, Terrell VIVERETTE, alleges that unknown Milwaukee police officers did throw him to the ground causing injury to his head and also removed U.S. currencies from his person without consent.

#### **INVESTIGATION:**

This investigation was conducted by Detective Michael CARLSON. On Thursday, February 8, 2001, he was notified by Sgt. Carianne YERKES to meet with Sgt. Milan STOJKOVIC at Mt. Sinai Hospital in regards to a battery complaint. The officers involved in this complaint had conducted a traffic stop of a vehicle in which Terrell VIVERETTE was a passenger. This occurred in the area of N. 36th Street and W. North Avenue. VIVERETTE was instructed by the officers on numerous occasions to remove his hands from his pockets and he refused to do so. The officers did remove him from the vehicle at which time VIVERETTE began kicking and had to be decentralized on the roadway. Sgt. STOJKOVIC arrived at the scene and did observe a laceration over the complainant's right eye and a large bumped on the right side of the back of his head. While at Mt. Sinai, being treated for his injuries, VIVERETTE complained that he was

accused them of battering him while they were at the scene. All of the officers and the ambulance personnel deny having struck the complainant at any time.

#### **CONCLUSION:**

In conclusion this case was reviewed by Deputy District Attorney Jon REDDIN on Friday, March 23, 2001. REDDIN did interview both the officers involved in this incident and decided not to issue any charges against either officer. He stated that the alleged battery and injury sustained by VIVERETTE occurred during the arrest, mainly the decentralization. He further indicates that he does not believe there is any criminal intent upon the officers to commit a battery. In regards to the theft of money, REDDIN stated that there is no evidence that anyone actually took any money from Mr. VIVERETTE and there is no way to establish how much money VIVERETTE had on his person prior to their contact with police. Based on Deputy District Attorney REDDIN'S review of the case it will be cleared as warrant refused.
