There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. See attached police report or correspondence.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

Limited parking for persons attending meetings in City Hall is available at reduced rates (5 hour limit) at the Milwaukee Center on the southwest corner of East Kilbourn and North Water Street. Parking tickets must be validated in the first floor information booth in City Hall.

This report is written by Police Officer Gilbert Gwinn, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

Applicant is also the licensee of the Class B premises, Taqueria El Jalapeno, at 2106 West National Avenue. Following is his premises record.

1. On 11-18-2003, subject was issued citation for Fire Prevention Enforcement, at 2106 W National Avenue.

2. On 4-18-2005 at 2:11 am, Milwaukee police were sent to a fight at 2106 W National Ave. Upon investigation, it was learned that a fight started between 3 patrons of the El Jalapeno tavern. Two were treated at Froedtert Hospital for stab wounds. One received 35 stitches to his stomach and left side of his face and one other received 4 stitches to his left side of his face and required surgery for a large laceration to his stomach.

3. On 03/18/09 at 8:25 am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 2106 W National for a Burglary complaint. Investigation revealed an entry did occur with cash being removed from the video games and jukebox. A report was filed.
4. On 04/26/09 at 11:49 am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 2106 W National for a Subject With Gun complaint. Investigation revealed a male entered the business with the lower portion of his face concealed pointing a gun demanding money from the clerk. The clerk failed to comply and the suspect became angry and while fleeing the premise, kicked out the plexiglass window of the front door. Nothing was obtained and no injuries were reported.

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5. On 05/08/2009 at 4:38am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 2106 W National (El Jalapeno Restaurant) for a Battery complaint. Investigation revealed one customer of the restaurant was beaten by another. This battery resulted in the victim receiving stitches. Police report #091280025 was filed.
6. On 05/23/2010 at 2:39am, Milwaukee police were flagged down by a citizen who related that the restaurant near 21st and National Avenue was still serving alcohol. Officers conducted a license premise check of the business at 2106 W National (El Jalapeno Restaurant) and discovered that the business was still serving alcohol to customers. Additionally, officers were unable to locate a sign indicating the business's maximum capacity. Police spoke to the victim who stated that a known subject punched him in the face while he was inside the El Jalapeno Restaurant. The suspect was still on scene and was issued a citation and later observed by officers leaving in a truck with friends. Around 4:05 am, a shooting occurred in front of the restaurant with the victim of the earlier battery being the suspect and victim of the shooting being the suspect from the earlier battery.

9. On 04/08/12 at 3:08 am, Milwaukee police responded to a Fight complaint at 2106 W National Avenue. Investigation revealed that a fight started inside the restaurant with two males fighting and as the fight intensified, more patrons became involved. Officers spoke with Whesley Rios, who works as a security guard for the restaurant and obtained his statement regarding the incident. Police also spoke with the manager Everardo Gutierrez-Garnica regarding the incident. He stated his brother Angel Gutierrez-Garnica was out of the country for a family medical emergency and was unable to be contacted. Police observed security cameras mounted in the restaurant, but when officers asked to view the video of the fight, were told by Everardo that he didn't have a key to locked video room located in the basement. Police issued several citations to patrons involved in the fight.

The officer then spoke to the applicant by phone and advised him of the complaint. During this check, it came to the officer's attention that Hernandez-Bruno did not have a valid class D operator's license. Both Hernandez-Bruno and the applicant were cited.



This report is written by P.O. Guadalupe VELASQUEZ, assigned to District 2, Early Shift.

On Monday, October 26, 2015, we received an aldermanic complaint from Alderman Donovan's office that stated that El Jalapeno was selling liquor to customers after hours.

On Saturday, October 31, 2015, at approximately 9:03 p.m., Squad 2266 (P.O. DIENER/ P.O. VELASQUEZ) conducted a license premise investigation at 2106 W. National Av. Upon arrival I spoke to Noemi HERNANDEZ-BRUNO who stated she was the waitress and that the licensee was not on scene. I advised HERNANDEZ-BRUNO about the complaint and she stated that they always have problems with intoxicated subjects after bar time and the same subjects always request to be served beer and liquor. HERNANDEZ-BRUNO stated they call police all the time (A CAD check revealed that there were no calls for service for this type of complaint). HERNANDEZ-BRUNO contacted the licensee by phone and I advised him of the complaint. I also explained to him that if this activity was occurring it needed to stop immediately.

After speaking to the licensee, I requested to see HERNANDEZ-BRUNO's Class D bartender's license. HERNANDEZ-BRUNO stated she did not have it with her. I asked if she was certain that she had one and she replied yes. I explained to HERNANDEZ-BRUNO that if she lied a citation may be issued and she replied she had no reason to lie.

A check of License Information Reporting and Administration System (L.I.R.A) revealed that HERNANDEZ-BRUNO had a Bartender License #64013 but it had expired on 12/31/11. An additional check of L.I.R.A. on Monday, November 2, 2015 revealed that HERNANDEZ-BRUNO applied for a Class D Bartender's License on 11/2/15.

I contacted the licensee who stated that the server had taken the courses regarding responsible alcohol sales and explained that she was still required to have a Class D Bartender's License. I advised the licensee he would be cited and he stated that he was present at the location and that he had only been gone from the location for approximately 3 minutes from when the server called him by phone.

The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place on 9/27/2016 at 9:00 AM, in Room 301-B, Third Floor, City Hall. If you wish, you may provide testimony at the hearing regarding the request; see below for further information. You are not required to attend the hearing. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing. Please review the information below and if you have further questions regarding this process, please contact the License Division at (414) 286-2238.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
 - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
 - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
 - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
 - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.
Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.



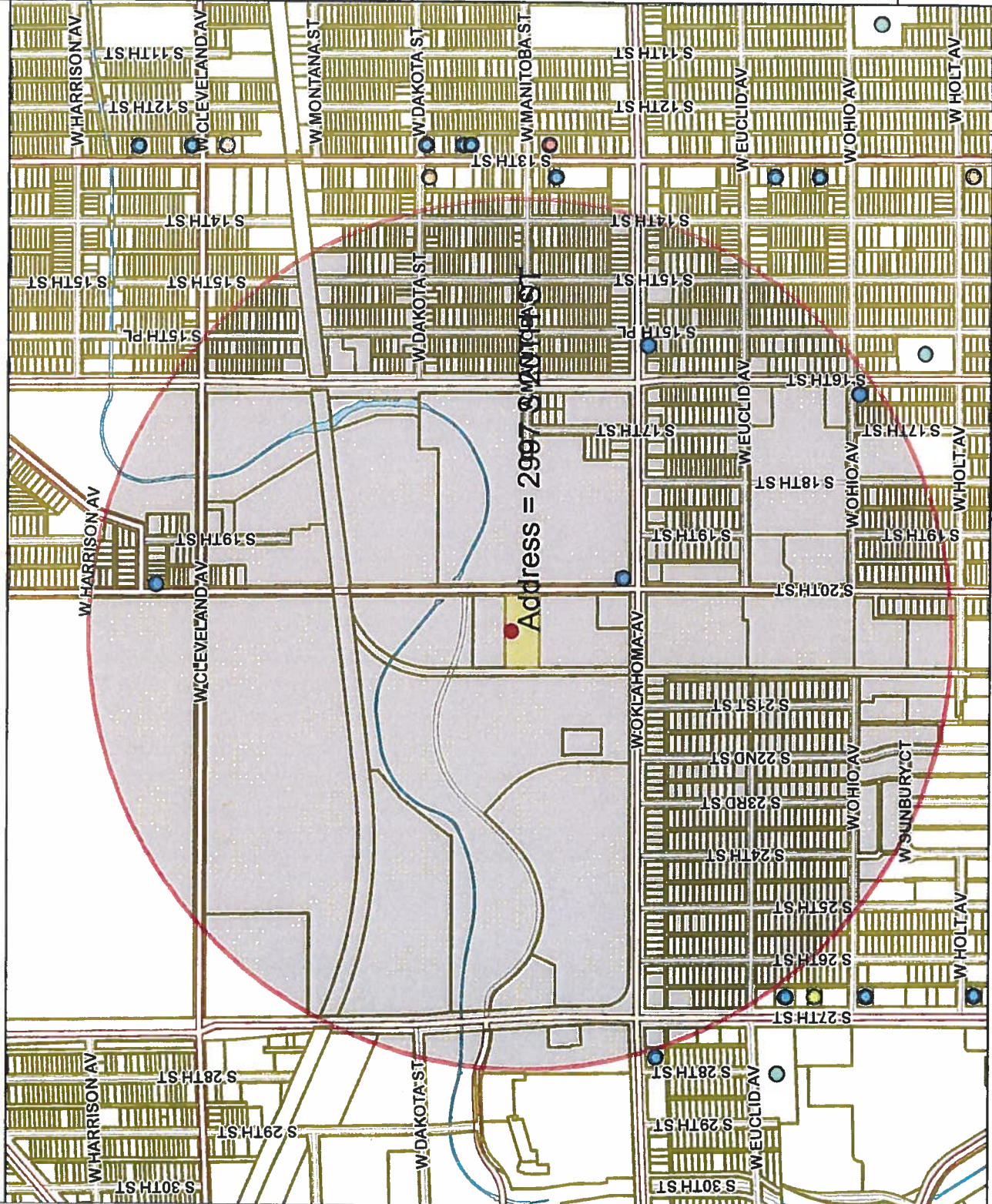
On 08-22-16 at 3:00PM I met with Ruben A. Burgos (M/W, 04-20-61), who is the president of Mexican Fiesta and will be the licensee of the new hall which is currently under construction at 2997 S. 20th St. He stated he anticipates the opening date to be three to four weeks from 08-22-16. BURGOS explained the new hall would be used for special events and family type events such as weddings, sweet 15 parties, baptisms, business events among other family events. BURGOS stated all food, liquor, and other vendors would be contracted out. He stated at a minimum, there would be one manager from Mexican Fiesta and one contracted security personal at all events. All food would be catered and contracted out.

Currently the hall and adjoining rooms are under construction. The Mexican Fiesta hall is very large in size. The main hall has a capacity of 500 people. On the east side of the hall is a smaller hall, which will be used for smaller events. There will be bathrooms located between each hall. West of the large hall will be a kitchen and additional bathrooms. West of these rooms will be storage and office space.

BURGOS stated the hall space is wired for 6 interior cameras and 4 exterior cameras, but have yet to be installed due to construction. There is also a large on site parking lot, which will be accessible to patrons. BURGOS was extremely cooperative and was interested in working with officers for further CPTED guidance.

This report is being written by P.O. Christopher JACKSON, assigned to District Six, power Shift.

On Saturday, August 15th, 2015 at approximately 2:09am Milwaukee Police Squads were dispatched to 1577 W. Morgan Av. in the City of Milwaukee for a Fight complaint. Upon arrival to the location squads had two subjects in custody regarding the incident at 3437 S. 16th St. in the City of Milwaukee.

The subjects involved in the incident were identified as Ricardo PADILLA M/W 02/06/90 and Carlos J. GONZALEZ M/W 09/09/91. I along with P.O. Henry DUMMAN III assigned to Squad 6468 arrived on scene at approximately 2:16am to assist officers.

Upon our arrival to the scene we took temporary custody of GONZALEZ and had him sitting in the rear passenger compartment of our marked squad. While seated in the rear compartment GONZALEZ stated that he just left the club. When asked which club he left he replied: "Right there, at Coops on the corner". He stated that he went to the location with girlfriend, his cousin (PADILLA) and his girlfriend. GONZALEZ stated that he stays with his cousin (PADILLA) and while inside the tavern after having drinks that PADILLA told him that he had to move out. He then stated that the two of them began to argue back and fourth and began to walk out the tavern. While out the tavern GONZALEZ state that PADILLA said something disrespectful about his girlfriend. He then stated that the two began to push and wrestle each other walking across the street and to the location were officers stopped the subjects.

The information was relayed to Squad 6437, P.O. Justin JOLLIFF and Squad 6331, P.O. Mathew WAGNER whom were the primary responding squads. The end result at the time was that the subjects were advised to leave the area and travel in different directions. Neither subject had injuries or complaints after being separated.

On Wednesday, August 19th, 2015 I conducted follow-up regarding this call for service. I contacted the caller of the original call who wishes to remain anonymous. The caller stated that while in their home they began to hear a loud argument-taking place outside. As they looked outside their window they observed a large group of subjects yelling at each other and causing a disturbance while leaving out the rear door of Coops tavern. The caller then states that the group begins to push and shove each other causing a fight between them. The group then crossed the street and was moving on south 16th St. northbound on the west side of the street. Responding squads then stopped both subjects at the address 3437 S. 16th St. The caller stated they wanted the subjects issued citations regarding the disturbing conduct.

After calling several times and leaving a voicemail message for the tavern owner Jason MOELLER, the owners' wife Lynn MOELLER contacted me. L MOELLER stated that she is the only person that knows how to use the cameras recording system. I met with L MOELLER on Wednesday, August 19th, 2015 at Coops tavern and reviewed the video. The video shows the subjects all together in the tavern and there is no incidents that take place inside.

Coops tavern was not issued any citations for violations. The two involved individuals will be issued Disorderly Conduct citations regarding.

This report is being written by Police Officer Christopher JACKSON, assigned to District Six, Power Shift.

This report is being written due to the continued call for service calls for the listed location of 1577 W. Morgan Av. (Coop's tavern) In the City of Milwaukee.

On Saturday, October 3, 2015 at approximately 1:06am Milwaukee Police Department received a trouble with subject call at the intersection of South 16th St. and West Morgan Av. The call stated that the caller lived near by a bar in the area and there were subjects in the street arguing. The caller believed that the subjects were about to be involved in a physical confrontation. While still on the line with the dispatcher the caller then states that she can see subjects exiting their vehicle and leaving the car doors open. There was no description of vehicles given before the callers phone line disconnected.

I along with Police Officer Michael KROHN responded to this call for service. Officer KROHN and I were one of the first squads on scene and did not observe any subjects arguing or vehicles left with the doors open. Officers only observed 4 subjects outside the bar on the north opening of the bar smoking cigarettes but not causing a disturbance.

I attempted to contact the caller only identified as "Tracy" on the number listed in the cad call. I was unable to reach anyone at the number. Officers checked the area for several minutes before returning to general patrol.

On Saturday, October 3, 2015 at approximately 2:24am Milwaukee Police Department received a second trouble with subject call at 3516 S. 16th St. in the city of Milwaukee. The call stated that there was a large group of subjects near Coop's bar arguing.

Officer KROHN and myself again responded to this call for service. As we arrived on scene we observed several vehicles near the west side of Coop's Tavern in the street and also blocking the intersection at West Morgan Av. and S. 16th St. As we approached closer the vehicles then began to flee in all different directions. One vehicle that stuck out to officers was a gray 2dr Oldsmobile with no plates. The vehicle began driving on the left side of another vehicle at a high rate of speed operating on the wrong side of traffic northbound on the 3400 block of S. 16th St. Officers stopped the vehicle at the intersection of W. Holt Av. and S 15th Pl. The subject was issued citations regarding.

Officers, after the interaction, contacted the caller, that wished to remain anonymous regarding her call. She stated that, the loud subjects outside the bar woke her. She stated, when she looked out her window, she observed the subjects exiting and around the bar in the street being loud and revving their engines. The subjects were being so loud that her daughter began to wake up also, so she called. She stated that minutes later a police squad arrived on scene and vehicles began to leave in all directions. She stated that one of the main vehicles that were causing the noise was then being followed by the police squad and later stopped up the street.

The female expressed her concern of the bar and its activity within the past year. She stated that she received a letter to go to a common council hearing regarding the bar but was unsure of the consequence of attending. She stated that she knows that a Milwaukee police officer owns the bar and that she is married to one of the original owners. She stated that she does not want to be the one to get anyone in trouble but is worried about the activity at the bar possibly endangering the safety of her daughter.

This report is being written by P.O. Christopher JACKSON, assigned to District Six, Power Shift.

On Sunday, April 17, 2016 I along with P.O. Henry DUMMANN responded to assist Sq. 6351, P.O. Brandon BARANOWSKI and Sq. 6320, P.O. Jose RIVERA on a fight complaint at S. 16th St. and W. Morgan Av.

At this intersection there is bar identified as Coop's tavern at 1577 W. Morgan Av. in the City of Milwaukee. Upon arrival to the location I observed two white females standing on the Westside of the building. When I briefly spoke with the two individuals they stated that they were in the bar earlier and are now waiting for a ride home.

I then entered the tavern and spoke with the bartender Abigail Ruth SINDELAR (F/W 09-25-84). SINDELAR stated that she normally works on Thursday nights and had a group show up that she did not recognize. She stated that one member in the group was a white male that was intoxicated when he walked in. The subject while seated at the bar began to fall asleep and she talked to the other members in the group about removing the subject. SINDELAR stated the two other males in the group walked the subject out the bar and returned to meet with the other two females in the group. She then stated that the subjects remained in the bar till bar close at 2:20am. She had no further incidents with any other subjects in the tavern.

SINDELAR had all updated licenses for herself and for the tavern.

I was able to contact the caller that wishes to remain anonymous regarding this incident. The caller stated that while in his nearby residence he/she was woken by subjects arguing loudly back and fourth. When he/she looked out the window they could see one white male subject stumbling walking southbound from W. Morgan Av. and S. 16th St. There was also two males arguing with two females near the tavern on S. 16th St. The male subjects drove off in a vehicle and the females were left behind. The anonymous caller stated that drunk subjects are always leaving the bar being loud and disturbing the peace in the area.

I attempted to contact the owner of the tavern on Tuesday, April 19, 2016 and had no response. A voicemail was left along with a call back number.

No citation was issued to the tavern regarding.

This report is written by P.O. Latanya DIEDRICH, assigned to District 6, Early Shift. On Thursday, 4-7-16 at 8:55pm, while assigned to Squad 6231, I, P.O. DIEDRICH, along with Squad 6250, P.O. Frederick TERRIQUEZ, Squad 6262, P.O. Raymon PORCHIA, and P.O. Esteban ARREGUIN, and Squad 6260, P.O. Ramon LASTRILLA and Squad 6212, Sgt. Eileen DONOVAN-AGNEW were dispatched to a fight complaint at 1577 W. Morgan Ave. An anonymous citizen called District 6 to report that there was a fight outside of the bar, Coop's Tavern located at 1577 W. Morgan Ave. The actors fled the scene before our arrival. I spoke with the bartender, CAVAZOS, Vyronica J (W/F 9-20-88) who stated a group of females came into the bar to celebrate a birthday. CAVAZOS stated one of the females became loud and disorderly inside the bar, and tried to start an altercation with another group. CAVAZOS stated she walked around the bar and split the group up and told each party they needed to leave. CAVAZOS stated one half of the group exited through the front door, and the other group left through the rear. CAVAZOS stated she did not know if anything happened outside after they left.

PA-33E Narrative

On May 10, 2016 at 1:23am, I along with P.O. Philip Rodriguez responded to 1577 W. Morgan Ave (Coop's Tavern) for an officer assist in the City and County of Milwaukee.

The following squads also responded and were on the scene of this investigation:

- Squad 6331 (Police Officers Dustin LANGFELDT and Matthew WAGNER)
- Squad 6468 (Police Officers Michael KROHN and Phillip RODRIGUEZ)

The original incident involved a fight that started inside the bar, the licensee, Jason L. Moeller (w/m, 12-13-69) saw the incident occur while he was watching live feed surveillance cameras at home. Milwaukee Police Sergeant Lynne Moeller (wife of licensee) who was off duty then responded to the bar when told of the disturbance.

Upon arrival Sqd 6331(P.O. Dustin Langfeldt and P.O. Matthew Wagner) observed off duty Sgt. Lynn MOELLER on the west side of Coops bar pointing at subjects on the south side of Coops bar, stating that she was just assaulted by them. The two subjects were later identified as Rosalinda BARAJAS w/f 05/08/92 and Laqueena M. HICKS b/f 02/15/93 and Sqd 6331 was able to detain them.

Moeller stated at some point after she arrived, Hicks and Barajas were outside and in the back of the bar. Moeller had words with the subjects, when she was walking to the front door, at which point Moeller identified herself as the bar owners wife and a police officer. Sgt Moeller stated she went to the front door and went to go inside the bar. As Moeller entered the bar and attempted to close the door, both females lunged forward and grabbed the door. Moeller and two other male patrons attempted to pull the door closed but the pressure on the door caused the hinge to buckle. This jammed the door so the females were able to reach past the door and grab Moeller by the hair. Moeller reported that she was first grabbed on the right side of the head then pulled forcefully on the left side of her head. This forceful pull threw her off balance and she was pulled out of the doorway. Moeller then claimed that while her hair was being pulled she was punched in the face and nose causing pain and discomfort. Hicks and Barajas were arrested and charged for battery to Law Enforcement Officer.

I then spoke to the bartender Vyronica J. Cavazos (w/f, 09-20-88) who stated that two subjects in the bar were becoming loud, these subjects were later identified as Hicks and Barajas. Vyronica (bartender) stated that she had cut them off and told them she was not serving them. Vyronica (bartender) stated that Hicks and Barajas became upset and started causing a problem. Vyronica (bartender) stated Hicks kept asking why at which point Victoria Cavazos (w/f, 10-20-84 and bartender's sister) told Hicks that she was being cut off. Vyronica (bartender) stated that she kept cleaning up and then heard a commotion and saw a fight break out which involved Victoria (bartender's sister), Hicks and Barajas. Vyronica (bartender) stated that patrons in the bar helped in trying to break up the fight and eventually were able to get Hicks and Barajas out the front door of the bar. Vyronica (bartender) stated that she did know who started the fight.

In an interview with Victoria (bartenders sister) she stated that she had an altercation with Hicks and started the fight by grabbing Hicks by the hair and punched Hicks. I then watched surveillance video which shows exactly what Victoria (bartenders sister) stated. I also saw on the video that Vyronica (bartender) was standing by the bar when the fight broke out and at one point jumped over the bar top and tried to break up the fight. The story Vyronica (bartender) originally told me did not coincide with what was told by Victoria (bartenders sister) and what I observed on the surveillance video. I did go back and requestion Vyronica (bartender) about what I saw. Vyronica (bartender) denied that she saw the fight start or being directly involved in breaking up the fight.

Victoria (bartenders sister) was cited onscene for assault and battery to Hicks and then released from scene.
