**N. Maryland Ave. – E. Newberry Blvd. to Kenwood Blvd. (ST211160106):**

Asphalt pavement resurfacing, replace curb and gutter, sidewalk and driveway approaches where necessary, sodding (11-foot width of tree border area), and grading.

**4th Aldermanic District**

**W. Juneau Ave. – N. 17th St. to N. 20th St. (ST211160115):**

Install traffic calming speed hump(s).

**W. Mt. Vernon Ave. – N. 31st St. to N. 32nd St. (ST211160123):**

Install traffic calming speed hump(s).

**N. 18th St. – W. Highland Ave. to W. Vliet St. (ST211160114):**

Install traffic calming speed hump(s).

**W. Hope Ave./W. Maxwell Pl. – N. 51st Blvd. to W. Fond du Lac Ave. (TD04284001A):**

Asphalt pavement resurfacing, replace curb and gutter, sidewalk and driveway approaches where necessary, sodding (6-foot width of tree border area), and grading.
