BMAAC Presentation on BLM EdHub by Walter Lanier March 18, 2021

It will provide Black and Latino males (and ultimately others) a better and far clearer road map of the educational ecosystem by cataloging and coordinating the existing programs that exist for Black and Latino males in the city. The project has two core components.

- The first component includes cataloguing existing programs for Black and Latino males in the city by major the institutions, including a description of the respective programs, the underlying data and/or practices supporting the program, and any existing performance data.
- The second component will support efforts to strategically coordinate and strengthen targeted, existing educational programs by working with cohorts to effectively move through the educational ecosystem. The strategies include:
- Increasing dual enrollment of Black and Latino males from MPS's Black and Latino Male Achievement program into UWM and MATC
- Increasing participation of Black and Latino males form MPS's Black and Latino Male Achievement program into existing summer programs at UWM, Marquette, and/or MATC
- Exposing participants in the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee's African American Male Initiative to educational opportunities at MATC with an emphasis on dual enrollment and transfers (and, to a lesser extent, careers).
