### ADDITIONAL COMMENTS/RECOMMENDATIONS:

These additional notes are written by Police Officer Michael Ward, assigned to District 6.

5928 S. 27th St. was still open under current ownership during the time of my inspection. Inspection was conducted with new ownership partners. Some of the observations that were observed day of, is that of the current layout of the store by current ownership.

A discussion regarding site lines in and out of the store was had with listed subject. It was advised to remove advertisement signage on the windows to be able to see in and out of the store.

I was advised at the time of the inspection, there has been no discussion regarding a safe and the type of safe at the location to date.

A discussion regarding No Loitering signs and the Standing Complainant form was had. The Standing Complainant form and Contact guide was emailed for review.

A discussion regarding items that may be sold in the store that could be used as drug paraphernalia was had with listed subject.

Listed subject has not attended a Robbery Prevention class within 120 days. While on scene the listed subject was provided with an updated contact number (414-935-7967) and listed dates (June 5<sup>th</sup>, 2024, Sept. 4<sup>th</sup>, 2024, and Nov. 6<sup>th</sup>, 2024) for future classes.

Lighting appeared to be adequate, but was not observed during the hours of darkness.

The camera system observed will remain operational after the transfer of the business. All cameras, but one were operational during the time of the inspection. Listed subject was advised of the camera that appeared to be not working. Current ownership stated they already have a tech coming out to fix issue.

This concludes my additional report.




### City Concentration Map for 5928 S 27th St

The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place on 10/22/2024 at 2:30 PM in Room 301-B, Third Floor, City Hall. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to view the proceeding are able to do so via the City Channel – Channel 25 on Spectrum Cable – or on the Internet at http://city.milwaukee.gov/citychannel. Those wishing to provide oral testimony via internet are asked to contact the staff assistant, Yadira Melendez at (414) 286-2775 or stasst5@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

## Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
