Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.



3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
 - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
 - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
 - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
 - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.

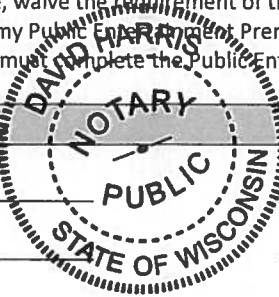

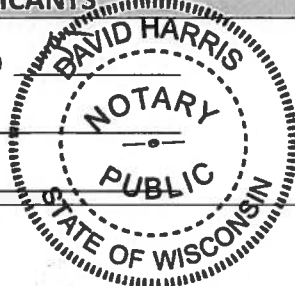

The new applicant, Sukhdev, does not hold any other licenses at this time

The store is primarily surrounded by residences. At 2979 N. Palmer, looks like this could be a day care, My Children's Learning Academy. Unsure if this is an open business at this time.

You can see clearly into and out of the business through the main entrance door. The two windows to the business, which are both on the south side of the building, are blocked by product and signage. The door that encloses the cash register area, also has signage on it. I did recommend that they reduce that signage to increase visibility.

Parking is on street only.

I did not observe any exterior lighting other than the street lights. So I would suggest adding lighting to both the south side and west side of the building.

They currently do have no loitering signs posted.

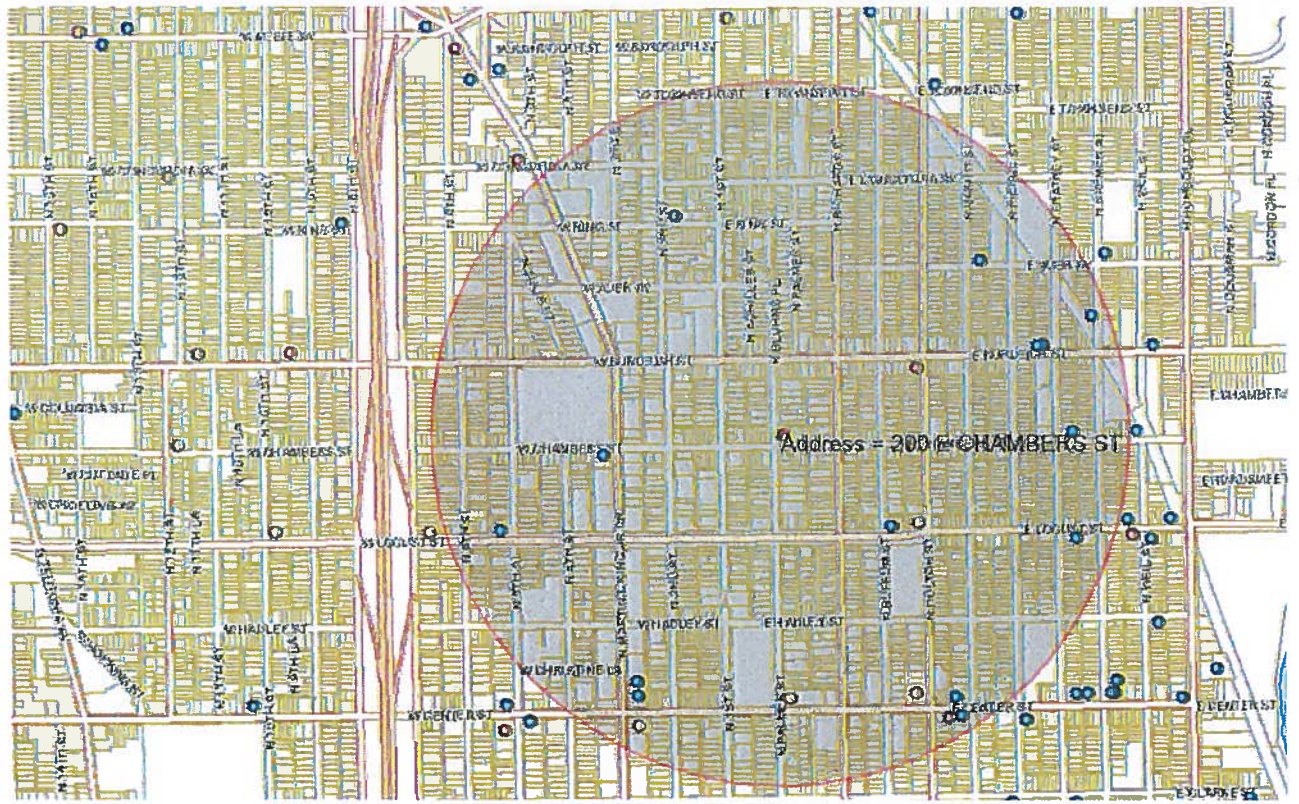
The address numbers need to be posted. I did observe the address numbers for 202 E. Chambers St. but not for 200.

The camera system is quite good. There are 8 interior cameras and 4 exterior cameras. The cameras footage is shown in color and recorded on a DVR type system. As of now, the footage is only stored for a one week time period. So that could be improved upon. All employees do not know how to access the footage, so that also could be improved. The cameras are placed well, and cover the entrance, the cash register area, and other areas inside and outside of the store.

The interior was very neat and clean. Product did look faced and well rotated. There is a food prep counter at the back of the store along the north wall with a food cooler. The prepared food was covered, and separated neatly. The sink and counter areas appeared very clean.

I did observe that the store does sell blunt wrappers, but they are behind the counter in the employee enclosure and off to the side so they are not in the main area where children would see them. I did not see any other items being sold that could be used as drug paraphernalia.

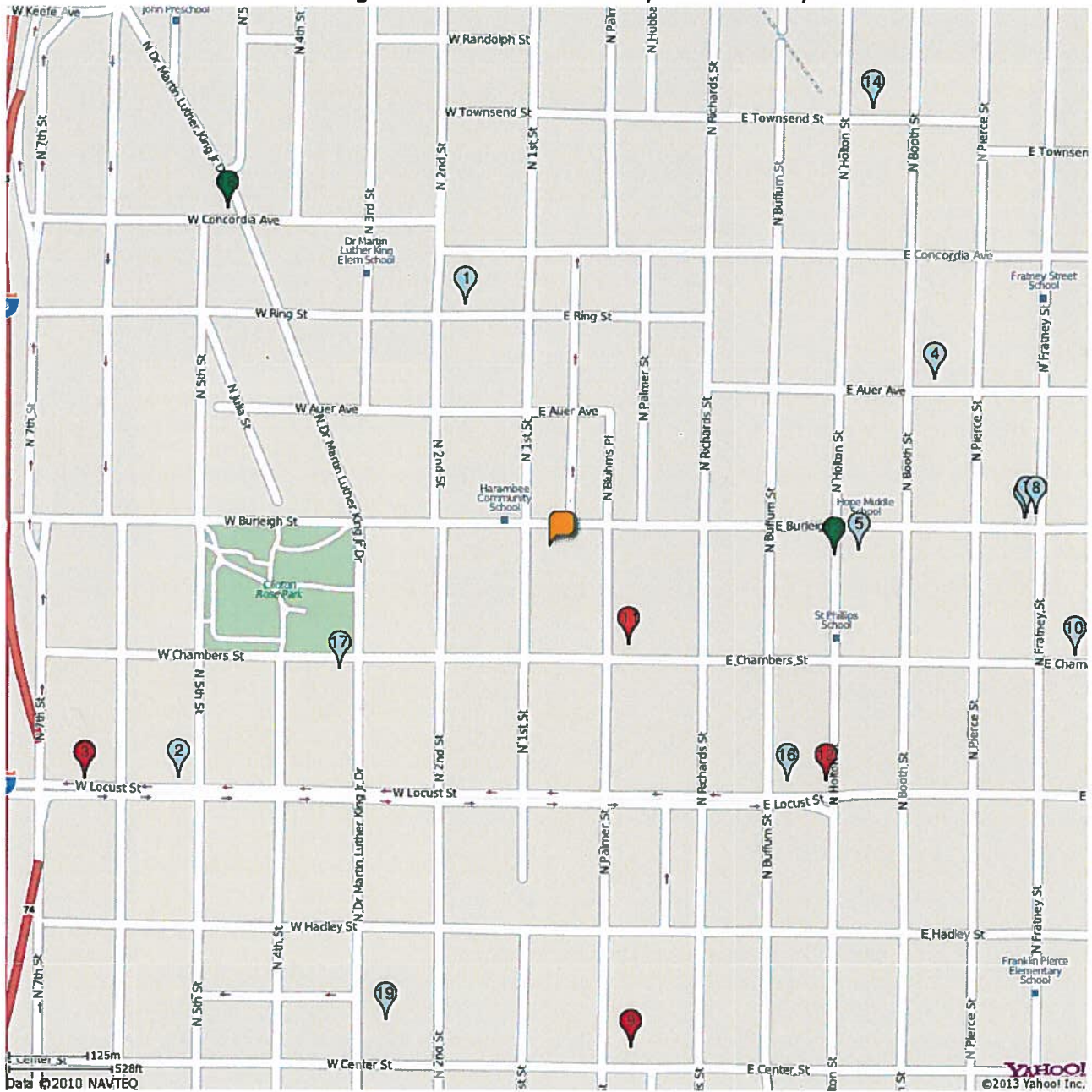
Mr. Sukhdev Singh has not yet attended the Robbery Prevention Training. I did provide him with the phone number to obtain information on when the next classes will be held.
