Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

SINGH gave permission to search the business and basement. The detective found evidence in the basement consistent with the trafficking of a child and a sexual assault.






PA-33E Narrative

This report is written by PO Penny BROWN assigned to the License Investigation Unit. On Thursday, October 29, 2015, I conducted follow up at All Star Food, located at 3100 N. 27th St. This was conducted as a result of a request from the City of Milwaukee Health Department.

On August 3, 2015, an inspection of the licensed premise was conducted by Health Inspector KARRIN. At that time Inspector KARRIN ordered the agent and his/her employees to attend the Robbery Prevention Course on October 8, 2015 at the Police Academy. Health Inspector conducted a re-inspection on October, 12, 2015 and found the agent and employees had not complied with her order.

I entered the store and introduced myself to the sole employee on scene, Sukhwinder SINGH A/M 09/05/94. SINGH stated they had complied, however, was not able to provide me with the certificates of completion. I then contacted Milwaukee Police Department Community Services and spoke to "Bertha", who stated she has no record of Sukhwinder or Varinder SINGH attending the October 8 class.

PA-33E Narrative

This report is being written by ***** assigned to Sensitive Crimes Division, Early Shift.

On Friday, March 25, 2016, at 7:30pm, Detective Steve Wells met Police Officer Christina Rutherford at the address of 3100 N. 27th Street regarding this incident. This address was the scene of a second degree sexual assault and trafficking of a child incident. One of the workers of the store was party to a crime of trafficking of a child and committed two counts of 2nd degree sexual assault of a child.

Detective Steve Wells processed this scene for any potential evidence. Once there Detective Steve Wells spoke to the store clerk, Kuldeeb Singh I/M 02-08-77. Detective Steve Wells explained to Kuldeeb that police were investigating an incident which occurred in the basement of this business. Detective Steve Wells told him that he wanted to search the basement of this business with his permission. He granted Detective Steve Wells permission and signed Consent to Search Form.

The scene of this incident 3100 N. 27th Street is a corner store with the name All Star Liquor. The building sits on the corner of 27th and Auer Ave. The entrance door to this store sits on an angle on the south east side of the store. After entering the store there is a cashier counter on the left. This cashier counter is enclosed in glass. In the rear of the store is a deli counter. Behind this deli counter in the back south east corner is a wooden stairwell leading to the basement.

The basement is where the victim states she was assaulted. This basement is very unkempt with dirt and trash everywhere. As you walk through the basement there is an open area at the opposite end. In the open area Detective Steve Wells found evidence consistent with the trafficking of a child and sexual assault investigation. These items were placed on Milwaukee Police Department inventory number 16010286.

PA-33E Narrative

This report was written by PO David NOVAK assigned to License Investigation Unit days. On Saturday May 14, 2016 I was assigned to work the Wisconsin WINS Youth Tobacco Initiative, which checks area vendors for age compliance tobacco purchases. Assisting in this assignment was a 17 year old who is not of legal age to purchase tobacco.

At approximately 9:55am the juvenile entered All Star Foods, 3100 N. 27th St. He attempted to buy a pack of cigarettes but was denied the purchase when he could not produce ID.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
 - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
 - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
 - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
 - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.
Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
