You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.



Our car was towed from a handicapped parking space at the Barnacle Bud/Skipper Bud lot between 6 and 7 PM on 6/13 by Action Towing, 4453 Noitrrth Green Bay Ave. On their website is info that they are open until 10 PM.


Neither Barnacle Bud's nor Skipper Bud's called Action Towing to request removal of our auto. When we called Action Towing, we were told that in order to pick up the car that evening prior to 10 PM, it would cost us \$ 100. This is in addition to a Towing Invoice of \$ 320.0. This seems to be unfair.

Have others complained about this towing company? We believe that this is "gouging" and wonder if their license permits this. We did pay thcoe \$ 320 and have our car back. Can anything be done to stop this company from gouging other? Is there any recourse for us?

RE: Complain Against Action Towing

Dear Linda M. Siefert:

This is a letter of complaint against Action Towing located on 4453 North Green Bay Avenue, Milwaukee, WI 53209.

On Wednesday, February 21st my husband and I went to Planet Fitness located on 5700 West Capital Drive (Midtown Center) around 5:00 p.m. At 6:39 p.m., he called me, to pick him up because his jeep was gone. I was told by one of the Planet Fitness employees the jeep was towed. I was parked in the handicapped spot but could not remember if he hung his handicap tag in his vehicle. We then drove to Action Towing that night to see if they had the jeep and we saw it through the gate. We went to District 4 Police Department to speak with an officer regarding the incident.

On Thursday, February 22 we arrived at Action Towing around 8:45 a.m. to see if the jeep was still there to pick it up. They were not open at the time, so we went back to District 4 and had a conversation with Officer Duckhorn regarding our situation, towing contracts, and towing scams. After the conversation with the officer, we drove to Planet Fitness and my husband asked the manager if they had a contract with Action Towing. The manager said they didn't have a contract with them. We then drove around to see if there were any signs located around the shopping center showing they were contracted with Action Towing. We did see a small sign when driving into the center and another small sign when we drove to another area of the center. We arrived back to Action Towing around 10:00 a.m. and the place wasn't open. There was a guy working on a vehicle in the garage, so my husband went to talk to him. My husband came back to our vehicle saying the guy had to call the worker and that she would be there in a few. When she arrived, my husband went in to take care of business. He wanted to speak to her manager, but she said he was out. When he came back to the vehicle, he was confused and disappointed. He told me he showed her his driver's license and the worker allowed him to go into his jeep to get his proof of insurance, the handicap tag, and the papers regarding the handicap tag. She said the cost to get the jeep back was \$350.00 and told him she was giving him a break for not charging him

a \$25 fee for not having insurance when he had insurance in the first place. She also wanted the title to the jeep. We don't keep titles in our vehicles and he wanted to know why she needed the title when all the information provided to her matched up proving the jeep was his. He also was wondering why it cost so much to retrieve his jeep when it was towed and picked up the next day before 24 hours. He was going to use his credit card but didn't, because there was a fee of 10% to use it. So, we had to go retrieve the title and go to the bank to get cash. When we arrived back to Action Towing, it was around 1:45 p.m. He gave her the title and she made a copy of it and his insurance information. He didn't think she should be making a copy of his vehicle title and insurance information. She would not let him have the jeep unless she had a copy of his information and the \$350.00 was paid to her. He just wanted his jeep back. My husband was able to drive off their property with his jeep between 2:00 p.m. and 2:15 p.m. She didn't even give him a receipt, so he had to go back inside to get it. He was given an invoice and when looking at it, it didn't look right. The "Vehicle Identification Number (V.I.N.)" wasn't written on the invoice and he was overcharged with fees he should not have been paying (see attached invoice). In fact, it was a standard invoice with fees customers had to pay if they wanted to pick-up a towed car. When adding the charges on the invoice, the total should have been \$345.00 and not \$350.00. Also, round trip towing from Planet Fitness to Action Towing is 8.8 miles and the jeep was not in their possession 24 hours. They had it overnight but not for 24 hours. They are lining their pockets off the backs of their customers by overcharging. We would like a refund of the overcharged fees he had to pay.

Questions we have are:

1. Did the tow operator contact local law enforcement with information regarding our jeep?
2. Did someone sign off on having the jeep towed?
3. Why was it a need for Action Towing to make a copy of the title and insurance information?
They can do anything with the information (use or sell the information, retake the jeep or have it stolen, etc.)?

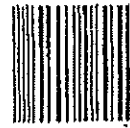

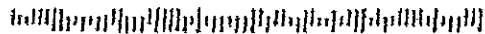

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

2. On 04/12/16, Milwaukee Police were conducting follow up an armed robbery-carjacking that occurred on 04/07/16. An officer was instructing by a Lieutenant to find out how Action Towing, located at 4453 N Green Bay Avenue, came into contact with the vehicle that was taken in the armed robbery. The officer was advised that Action had towed this auto and eventually called police to report they had a stolen car. Prior to heading to Action, a check of the AutoProcess computer found a valid tow reference number for this vehicle, but showed that the vehicle was towed in as a private property tow later than what Action told police when they called it in. This was in violation of city ordinance 93-47. Once at Action Towing, an officer spoke with the clerk, identified as Rebekah Bissen. Bissen stated to police that there was only one truck driver for Action and his name was Muhammad Abdus Salaam. Bissen stated she knew that Abdus-Salaam towed the vehicle at 8:00 am and brought it back to the shop. Bissen then called Abdus-Salaam and the officer spoke with him and explained why he was there and discussed towing ordinances and laws. The officer then went over the ordinances and laws with Bissen. Police looked at their fee schedule and found that Action was charging too much for their tows as they were adding several fees that they were not allowed by law to charge. Examples were a processing fee, an un-insured relocation fee, and extra fees for common tows that were not covered under Trans 319. Both Abdus-Salaam and Bissen were advised that tickets would be issued. On a later date, Abdus-Salaam met with an officer to discuss go over the laws and ordinances of Chapter 93.

3. On 06/21/19 at 12:05pm, a Milwaukee Police Officer from the Tow Lot Property Division received a telephone call from a representative of Enterprise Rental Car regarding a stolen vehicle that they reported to the Rockford Police Department in July of 2018. The representative said that they received a certified letter from the applicant on 06/12/19 stating that they (the tow company) had their vehicle for 365 days and would sell the vehicle on 06/24/19 if they did not receive a payment of \$9,445.00. The applicant towed the vehicle on 06/12/18 and Enterprise Rental Car reported the vehicle stolen in July of 2018. Under Action Towing certified letter, the applicant stated that this is the first attempt to contact Enterprise Rental Car.
4. On 06/21/19 at 12:54pm, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 4453 N. Green Bay Avenue to recover an out of jurisdiction stolen auto. Upon arrival, officers interviewed, by phone, the applicant who verified that the stolen auto was on the lot since May of 2018 and was reluctant to give the vehicle to police. Ultimately the stolen auto was recovered from the property.
5. On 08/13/19 at 9:58am, Milwaukee Police conducted a license premise check at 4453 N. Green Bay Avenue. Violations found during the inspection included; not keeping paperwork on site, some of the addresses he does consent tows for he does not have contracts, no RST sticker on his wrecker and his newest wrecker is not on file with the Licensing Division. The applicant was cooperative.


