John Coury founded Crestlight Capital in 2017 as a private real estate investment firm focused on office and mixed-use commercial investments within the eastern half of the United States, particularly high growth secondary and suburban markets in proximity to innovation and education hubs. Currently, Crestlight is based in Detroit and has approximately \$300 million in assets under management with properties located in Atlanta, Chicago and Milwaukee.

Prior to Crestlight, John worked at The Blackstone Group and was directly responsible for managing 75 assets with a total enterprise value of \$5.6 billion overseeing a team of 150 investment professionals at Equity Office Properties (Blackstone portfolio company) and a staff of 3 analysts. John managed office investments in 10 markets across the United States.

Prior to Blackstone, John worked as an Assistant Vice President at Rockwood Capital, a real estate fund with \$6.5 billion in assets under management, and was directly responsible for 9 office, retail and multifamily properties with a total enterprise value of \$745 million while also providing acquisition support in each market.

Prior to Rockwood Capital, John worked as an Associate Vice President at DTZ Rockwood underwriting 16 separate portfolio transactions totaling 9 million square feet.
