Mr. Grant F. Langley:

This is an appeal to the decision dated April 19, 2004, Postmarked May 20, 2004 and received by me on May 22, 2004.

I filed the action because I called and reported the vehicle stolen and the officer after checking stated the vehicle was towed for obstruction however, the officer stated that the steering column was not damaged, therefore he could not report the car as stolen. The officer was adamant about the column not being damaged.

When I went to retrieve something from the vehicle in the tow yard, the steering column was damaged. I called right away to correct the problem and was told that I needed to speak to the same officer, who had it towed, because no one else could help me. If the officer had changed his report I could have proceeded with whatever other options were available. However when I called, I was told that, no one else could help me because he was on vacation. I went to the tow yard and asked for an extension until I could get everything straighten out and pick up my vehicle. I was told that they couldn't do that a date was set and there was nothing that could be done about it unless I wanted to pay about \$1000.00 to get the vehicle out.

When I did get to speak with the officer who had the vehicle I was told again that the steering column was not damaged when the vehicle was towed and that he would not change his report. Later, I was also told that he checked and it appeared that it was damaged while at the tow lot and he filed the damage report for me.

Now I might be stupid and I hope that I am not stuck on stupid, but, if the vehicle was not stolen because there was no damage to the steering column when it was towed, and it didn't happen at the tow yard, it might have happen while it was towed or I'm just crazy and it didn't happen. At any rate it is the city's responsibility to repair and replace my vehicle. However, I suppose that this is just one of the ways that the city uses to beat people.

Therefore I am requesting a hearing on this matter.

My name is Walter Curtain and I'm having a problem that I hope you can help me to resolve. On 08/30/03 we filled out a vehicle theft report (see attached report). The officer who took the complaint stated to my daughter that the vehicle had been towed and the steering column was not broken. We were told that we would need to get the report, which would take 3 to 5 days to process. When my daughter called to see if the report was done, she was told that she could not pick up the report because the vehicle was in my name. In the mean time on or about September 05,2003 I went to the tow lot to get some things out of the vehicle and when I was escorted to the vehicle and opened the door I noticed that the steering column was broken. I went back and spoke to the lady at the tow lot and was told that the police officer that issued the report would have to change his report. I tried to call the officer, (Steven S. Johnson), at 414-935-7242 on or about September 15, 2003, I was told that he was on vacation until 9/24/03 and no one else could help me. I picked up the vehicle theft report on 9/16/2003 and notice that the disposition was unfounded - baseless, C10, Vehicle was Towed. When I finally spoke with Officer Steven S. Johnson, after he returned from his vacation, I explained that I had gone to the tow yard and that the steering column was broken. He called the officer who had the vehicle towed and was told that the steering column was not broken when it was towed. He told me that even though the steering column was broken that he still could not change his report. Officer Johnson then informed me that property damage report would have to be filled out because it seemed that someone had had broken the steering column while trying to still the vehicle from the tow lot. Officer Johnson agreed to file the report for me after confirming that the steering column was broken and again I was told that in 3 to 5 additional days I would be able to pick up a report. The report was filed on 10/22/2003 by Officer Johnson (See attached report). I called the Citation review department at 414-344-0840 who reviewed and sent me a notice that I would not have to pay for having the vehicle towed, however the first appointment that I could get to talk to the city's attorney was on December 22, 2003. I would need to speak to the city's attorney to have the charges dropped to recover my vehicle.

I then called the tow lot to speak to someone who could help with what to do next. I spoke with the operator and she stated that she understood my problem but I needed to speak with a supervisor a Mr.Black at 414-286-5092. When I called there was no answer and I left a very long message explaining everything and I left my number to be called back. I did not receive a call back.

The steering column was broken on my van and the door was taped open when I went to get the things out of it at the tow lot. I would like to be reimbursed for the door and the steering column and be able to retrieve my van from the tow lot.

Today, (December 22, 2003), I met with the city attorney's office only to find out that all he could do for me was to release the citation. The citation was already released on 10/23/2003 and I was then told that I needed to file a complaint with the city of Milwaukee. This letter should serve as the document needed stating the circumstances of the claim and the attachments will provide my address which is 5257 North 107th Street, Milwaukee WI 53225-3123. The damages sought are as follows:

- > \$500. For repairs of the steering column. (not able to get an estimate, van at tow lot) or
- > \$3500.00 for replacement of van.

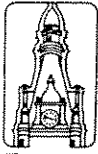
