REASON FOR REQUEST:

Carmen Rodgers, a City of Milwaukee Police Officer, was in the scope of her employment and operating a City of Milwaukee Police vehicle that was traveling westbound on West Burleigh Street in pursuit of a stolen vehicle (the uninsured motorist). As the City vehicle approached the intersection of West Burleigh Street and North 50th Street, the uninsured motorist lost control of the stolen vehicle and collided with the City vehicle, causing the accident. As a result of conduct of the uninsured motorist, there is liability on the City of Milwaukee pursuant to §62.67 Stats., and the City of Milwaukee's Uninsured Motorist Self-Insurance Plan.

Officer Rodgers sustained injuries to her neck and back. The treating physician indicated that the injury is permanent. The claimed medical expenses and lost wages total \$32,486.55.
