The President's Task Force on 21st Century Policing identified training to sustain resilience as a priority for research and evaluation. These interventions should equip officers with the tools to adapt and regulate during challenging or stressful situations. Resilience training improves officer performance, decision-making, and interactions with the public, as effective communication is essential to police-community relations and legitimacy. Research indicates that resilience training can improve both the physiological and psychological response to stressors and well-being.
