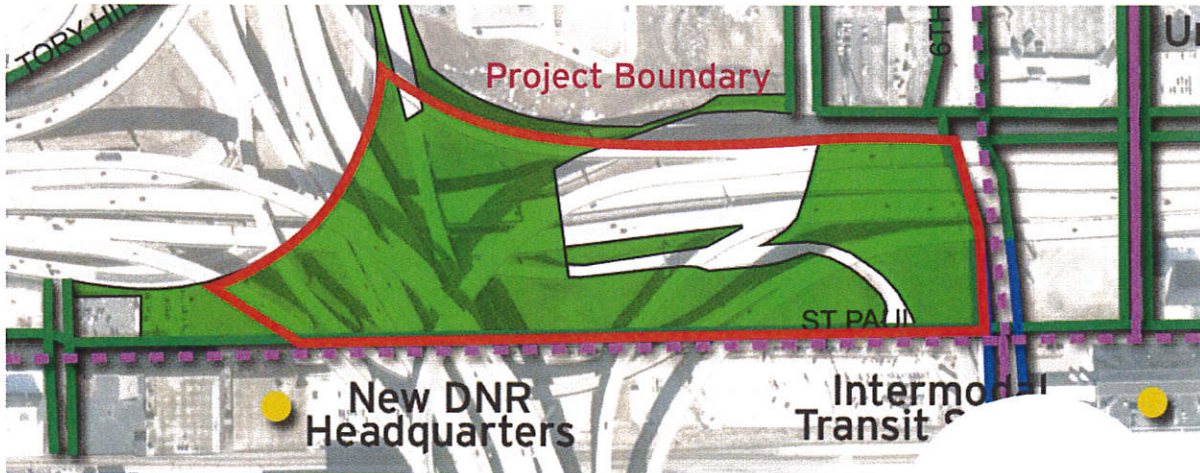




PUBLIC MEETING/OPEN HOUSE
