

(3) The requirements set forth in said amended detailed plan attached to this Common Council File as Exhibit A, con-stitute the zoning regulations for the area contained in such planned devel-opment district described, provided fur-ther, that the effect of the approval of such amended detailed plan is that such plan shall limit and control construction, location, use and operation of all land

ocation, use and operation of all land and structures included within the amended detailed plan to all conditions and limitations set forth in such amended detailed plan.
