-  = SIGNAL

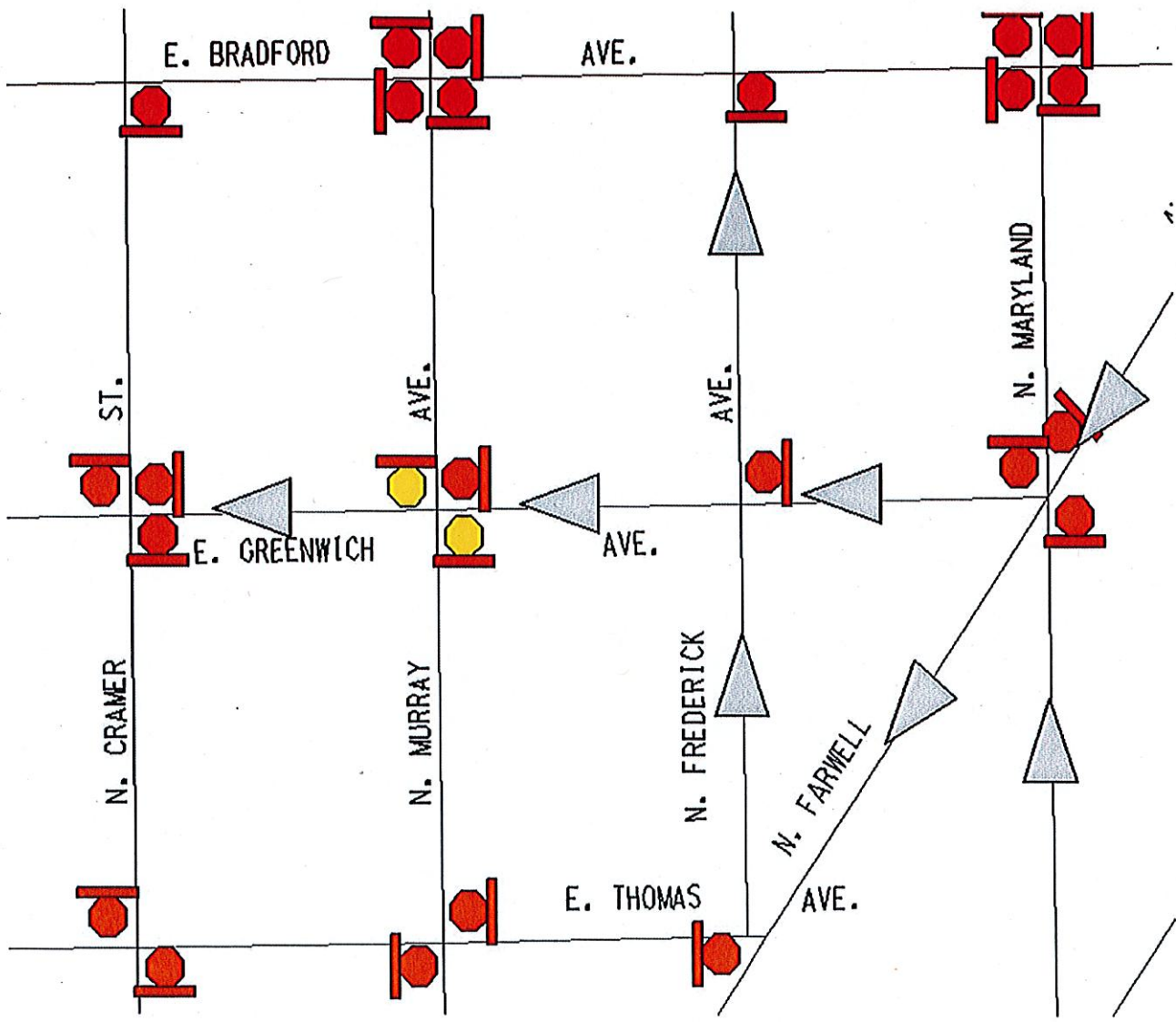
