We have received your claim in the amount of \$1,232.23, relating to damage sustained to your vehicle on December 3, 2007 at North 54<sup>th</sup> Street and West Hampton Avenue when a vehicle that was being pursued by the Milwaukee Police Department (MPD) struck your car.

Our investigation reveals that the Wisconsin Motor Vehicle Accident Report completed for this incident noted the vehicle was fleeing from the MPD. The primary liability for this accident rests with the individual that was fleeing from the police, as such, the City cannot accept liability and we are denying your claim.

If you wish to appeal this decision, you may do so by sending a letter within 21 days to the Milwaukee City Clerk, 200 East Wells Street, Room 205, Milwaukee, Wisconsin 53202, requesting a hearing.
