5. DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT:

The Community Garden at Kilbourn Park is entering its fourth growing season in 2012. We offer 133 garden beds (129 four-by-eight-foot beds, 4 four-by-twenty foot beds) that are gardened by individuals, families and neighborhood groups. These raised beds are not permanent construction, and have been installed on top of the ground in accordance with city guidelines for community gardens.

The gardens are managed by a coalition of neighborhood groups and volunteers. The land is owned by Milwaukee Water Works, and the garden operates under a lease with the city held by Milwaukee Urban Gardens (MUG).

We would like to erect a Gateway to mark the entrance to our gardens and offer small informational signs explaining what the gardens are and how neighbors can get involved.


The Gateway will have a "footprint" of approx. four-by-eight feet. It will have small benches on the inside. It will be constructed of debarked cedar branches that will weather to a silvery-grey color. The structure will have its four corner posts sunk into the ground and set on small concrete footings installed below the frost line.

The Gateway will be constructed off-site by LaLune Collections, a local company that has created indoor and outdoor benches, furniture and railings for the Urban Ecology Center, Alterra on Humboldt and at the Lakefront, as well as other local organizations. It will be moved to the Garden site and installed under the direction of consultants from LaLune and a local landscape architect, and with the help of volunteers from the United Way and the neighborhood.

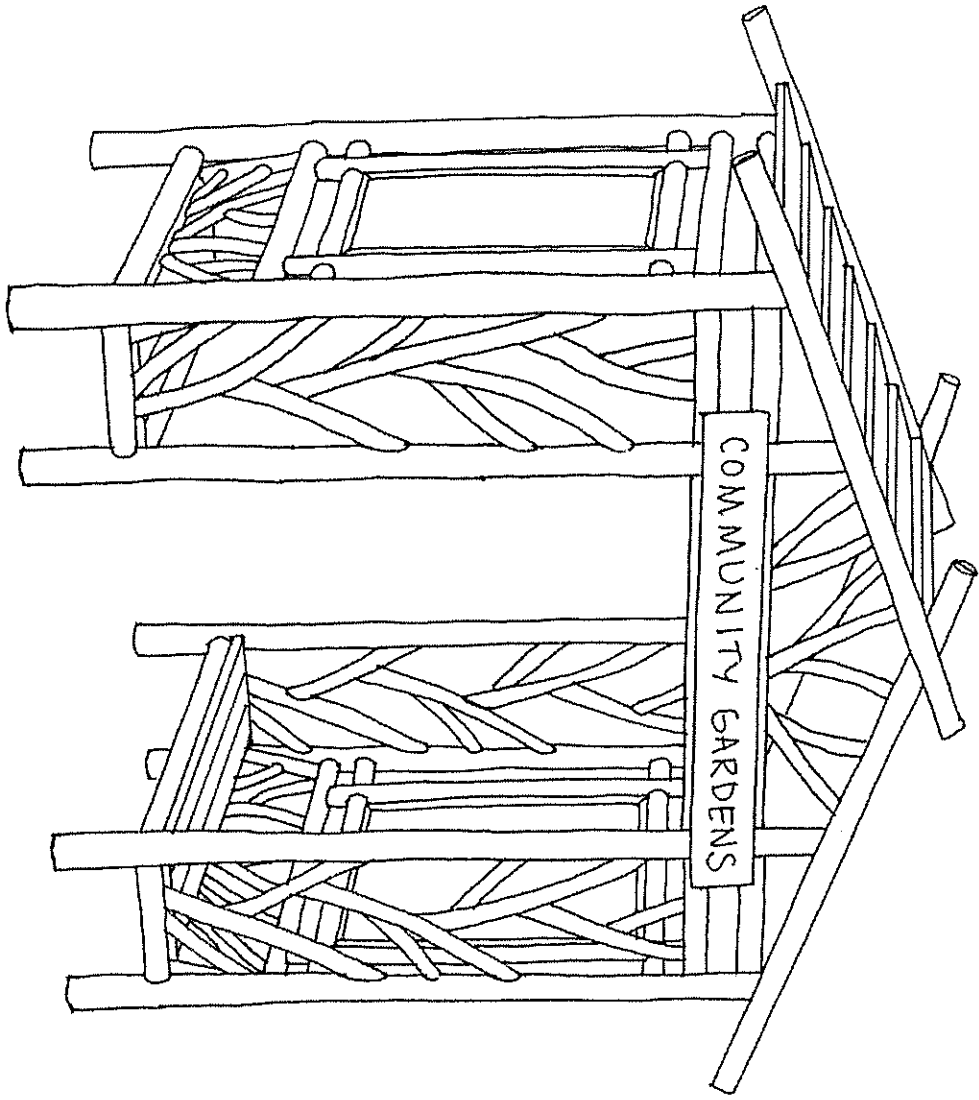

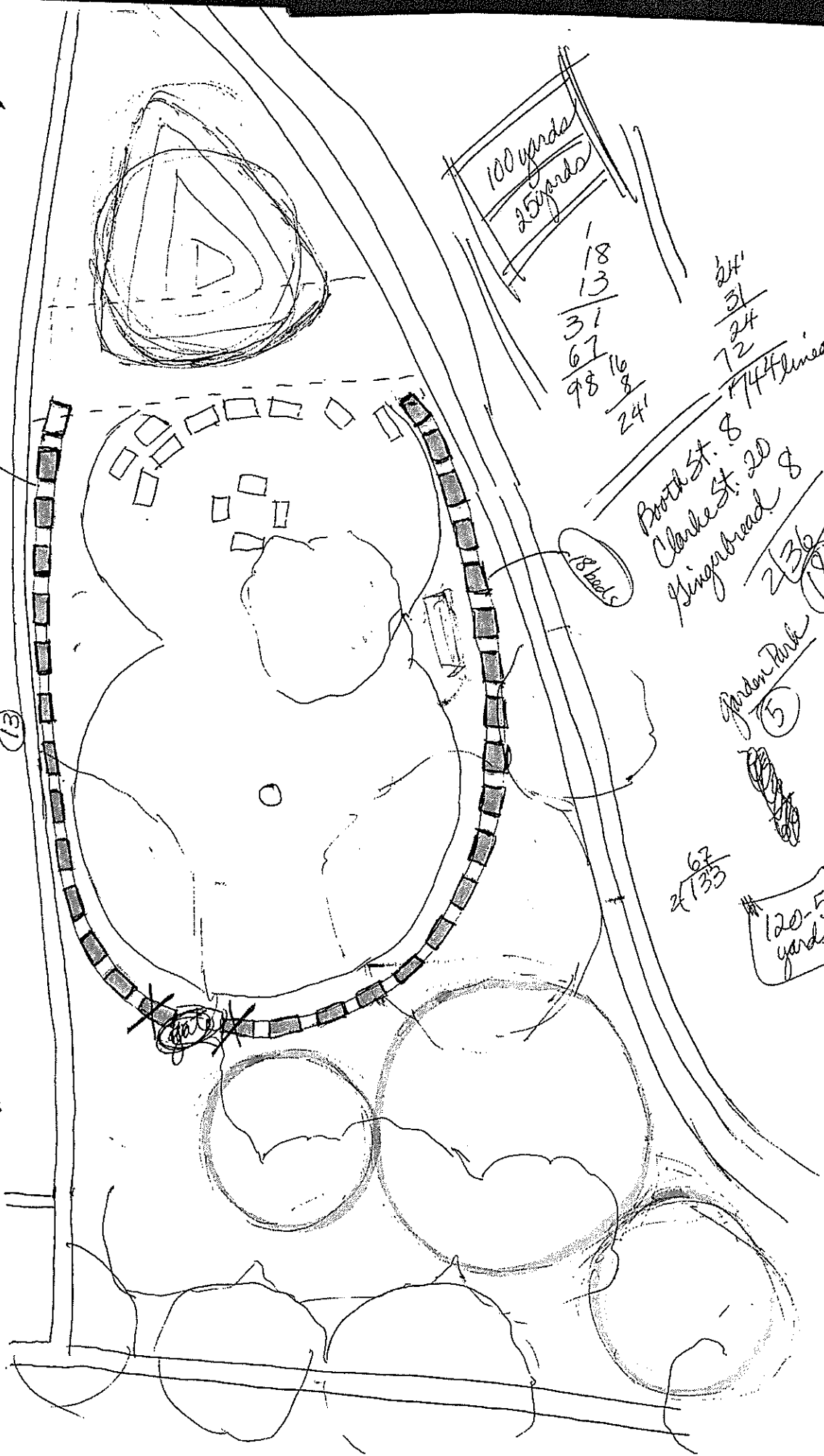

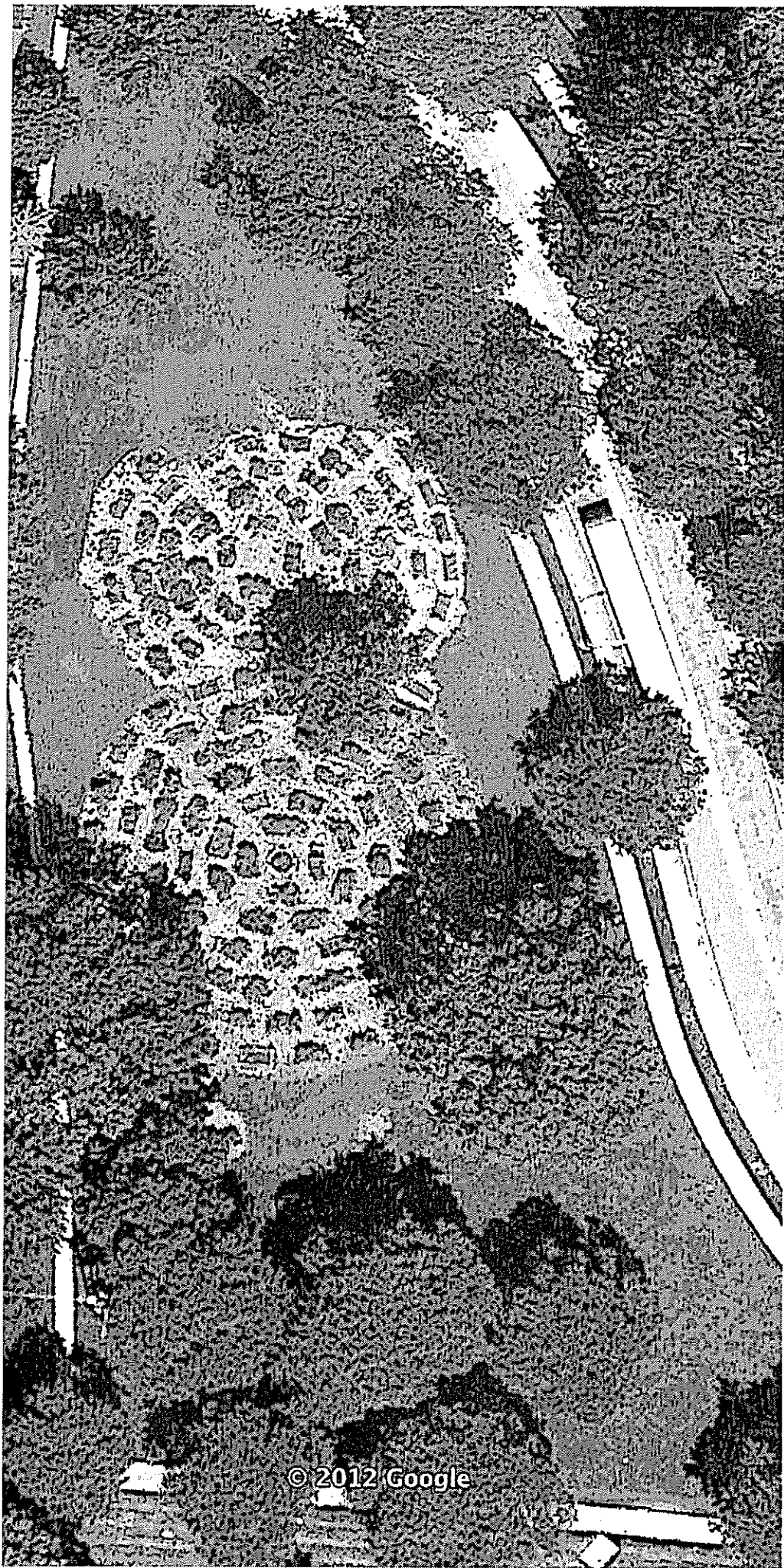
