This report is written by Police Officer David NOVAK, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

- 1. On 08/12/07 at 9:24 pm, Milwaukee police were dispatched to an Armed Robbery at 2210 W Keefe Avenue. Officers spoke to the victim and investigation found the victim was robbed while exiting the V & T Liquor store. The victim stated two suspects ordered him into his vehicle at gun point and was made to drive the suspects to 2210 W Keefe where he was robbed of his property. Police did view surveillance video from the liquor store and spoke to the manager, Timothy Pernell, who stated he was working at the time of the robbery. No injuries were reported.
- 2. On 04/01/2014 a stolen credit card was used to purchase liquor at V&T Wine and Liquor (916 West Burleigh Street). The investigating officer spoke to the applicant on 04/05/2014 and 04/09/2014 in an attempt to obtain store video of the transaction. On both occasions, the applicant told the officer he needed to contact a third party to retrieve the video and the officer would be contacted when this happened. On 04/13/2014, the officer again contacted the applicant about retrieving the video and was told at that time that the video was only retained for a week and had been overwritten.

3. On 08/30/2014 a 16 year old, working in conjunction with Milwaukee police, was able to purchase a Black and Mild cigar from the cashier at V and T Wine and Liquor (916 West Burleigh). The applicant was cited.

- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.

# **ADDITIONAL COMMENTS/RECOMMENDATIONS:**

A CPTED survey was done for this location in March of 2015.

Since then, there have been upgrades to the interior of the business to include a much improved security camera system, and a new enclosure for employees. There are now 3 exterior cameras and 5 interior cameras. The enclosure for employees does contain the register, and has a glass partition to separate employees from customers, as well as a door that can be locked to completely separate the area.

The entrance door has also been upgraded to a full glass door. It is fully covered with a sign right now, but they stated they will be removing that as soon as their ADT security system is installed next week.







### ADDITIONAL COMMENTS/RECOMMENDATIONS:

The current owner, Mrs. Love, has owner the store for many years and is selling the entire business as is to Mr. Gurpiar Singh. Singh stated that he has several other licenses, which are listed above, for his other store, North Avenue Liquor, 3013 W. North Ave.

Mr. Singh hopes to be operating this liquor store by the end of June, beginning of July. He states that he will work with Mrs. Love to learn how to operate the camera system, which is already in place and in good working order. I did inform him that we recommend the camera footage be stored for at least 30 days. He plans to use the same alcohol and beer distributor that he uses for North Ave Liquor. The store already has two safes, one in the lockable employee area out in the store that is a smaller safe but bolted into the ground; and a larger safe in the back. Mr. Singh stated that he did take the robbery prevention training and that the other person who will be working at the store with him has taken it as well.

- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.




