On Saturday, October 8, 2016, I was assigned to work the Wisconsin WINS Youth Tobacco Initiative, checking area vendors for age compliance tobacco purchases. Assisting in this assignment was Quaveion BROWN (B/M, 03/27/99, of 4229 N. 76<sup>th</sup> Street, Milwaukee, WI 53220). BROWN is 17 years of age which is not of legal age to purchase tobacco.

At approximately 11:01am, BROWN entered Navtej Bradley / Phillips 66 at 6011 W. Bradley Rd. and purchased one pk of Swisher Sweet cigars. BROWN described the cashier as an A/M, wearing a black shirt. 1 entered the store and immediately identified the cashier based on the description given. The cashier identified as Navdeep SINGH (A/M, 08/15/93) did admit to selling a pk of Swisher Sweet cigars to BROWN and not asking for his ID. SING was advised that I would be sending out a letter to enroll in the M.A.R.T.S. program. The Agent Ramandeep KAUR was not onscene.

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.




