Our traffic engineering staff has investigated this request and found that westbound motorists on East Bradford Avenue have a difficult time seeing pedestrians in the south crosswalk at North Farwell Avenue when vehicles park close to the corner. Therefore, in the interest of public safety, we recommend installing this restriction to increase westbound motorists' visibility of pedestrians at this intersection.

We will prepare the necessary legislation for the next Public Safety Committee meeting, so that you may support it to final passage.

Currently, there are a limited number of long-term on-street parking spaces in the perimeter areas of the Historic Third Ward District.
