
Re: File No. 130558, Resolution relating to a Certificate of Appropriateness to retain metal windows with grids that were denied earlier by the Historic Preservation Commission at 124 W. Lloyd St. in the Brewers Hill Historic District for John Dorsey

At a public hearing held on Monday, October 14, 2013, the Historic Preservation Commission (HPC), by a vote of four (4) ayes, zero (0) noes, and three (3) excused, granted a Certificate of Appropriateness to retain metal windows with grids at 124 W. Lloyd St., in accordance with the provisions of Section 320-21-11 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances, with the conditions that the metal grids of the front four windows be replaced with clear glass and the remaining windows to remain with metal grids. The Commission further moved to accept the withdrawal of the retaining wall request and that the fence request be considered at the staff level.

Upon granting of a certificate, Commission Staff shall issue a Certificate of Appropriateness. In the case of conditional granting of a certificate, the certificate shall only be issued upon your acceptance of the conditions placed on issuance of the certificate by the Commission.
