The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place on 6/26/2018 at 9:30 AM, in Room 301-B, Third Floor, City Hall. If you wish, you may provide testimony at the hearing regarding the request; see below for further information. You are not required to attend the hearing. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing. Please review the information below and if you have further questions regarding this process, please contact the License Division at (414) 286-2238.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.



This report is written by Police Officer David NOVAK, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

- 1. On 01/29/11 at 4:12 pm, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 27th and Atkinson for a Shots Fired complaint. Police spoke with a victim who stated he was shot by an employee of Hot Spot Super Market. The victim stated it occurred in front of the store and he was then transported by MFD to an area hospital for treatment. Police took photos of all employees, which were shown to the victim who identified Nader Ahmed Salem as the man who shot him. Salem was then placed into custody. Numerous other violations were observed in the store such as the sale of single cigarettes and batteries. Police also found two cans of pepper spray, a knife with a 5 inch blade, an empty gun holster and a scale.
- 2. On 05/24/11 at 12:45 pm, Milwaukee police as well as members from the the Department of Neighnborhood Services conducted a License Premise check at 2643 W Atkinson. A check was done to verify that the store had their camera system properly running. - 5. On 05/24/2013 Milwaukee police investigated the anonymous complaint that the store at 2301 West Hopkins Avenue is selling single cigarettes and purchasing illegal baby formula. Officers spoke to Mohammad Z. Abdelrahim who stated that no one in the store sells single cigarettes. No police reports or citations were written.
- 6. On 06/12/2013 Milwaukee police, along with Agent Erin Dorn of the Wisconsin Department of Revenue, conducted an inspection at 2301 West Hopkins Street (Family Supersaver). Agent Dorn confiscated over 300 packs of cigarettes that did not have a Fire Safety Code stamp, several individual cigarillos that were being sold outside their original containers and several packs of cigarillos for which there was no invoice. Hopkins St. The clerk was identified as the applicant. She stated she did not remember the sale. She was advised she would receive MARTS letter in the mail.



Rahim stated she did not remember selling McGee Swisher Sweet cigars. Rahim was advised that I would be sending out a letter to enroll in the M.A.R.T.S. program.
