

Ghaffar contacted "Jerry" and requested he removed the machines from his property immediately. Ghaffar was also advised that he and his employees need to attend the upcoming Robbery Prevention course. Ghaffar was cooperative and stated he would comply.



This report is written by PO Penny BROWN assigned to the License Unit.

On Wednesday, March 02, 2016, at approximately 9:30a.m., I conducted a license premise check at BP gas Station, located at 7965 N. 76th St., along with Agent Georgeanne KING, Department of Revenue, Alcohol and Tobacco.

This license premise check was based on a complaint the store was operating illegal gambling machines. On arrival Agent KING and I introduced ourselves to the manager (Mohammed A. GHAFER A/M 10/12/55). GHAFER is the brother of the agent (Haji S. GHAFER A/M 09/01/51) who is currently out of the country. GHAFER was advised of the reason for the inspection and Agent KING requested to see the entertainment machines. GHAFER showed us three entertainment machines, and stated he did not own them, they were provided by a man named "Jerry". Agent KING asked GHAFER if the machines paid out any winnings, to which GHAFER stated they do. GHAFER provided Agent KING with several receipts in which the machine will print out upon a customer winning. The customer will then take the receipt to the cashier of the store and receive the cash from the receipt. GHAFER stated he thought this may be illegal and therefore consulted with an attorney, however, the attorney told him they were legal. GHAFER contacted "Jerry" and requested he remove the machines from his property immediately.

During the investigation I also advised GHAFER that he and all of his employees need to attend the upcoming Robbery Prevention course on April 7. GHAFER was extremely cooperative and stated he would comply. Follow up will be conducted to ensure all machines have been removed and all employees took the Robbery Prevention Course.
