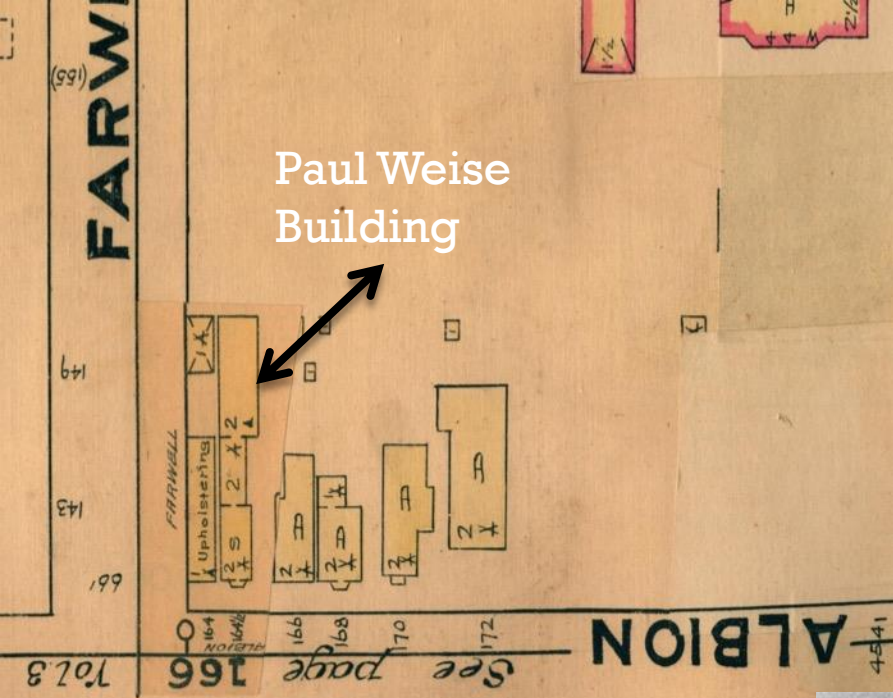

1888

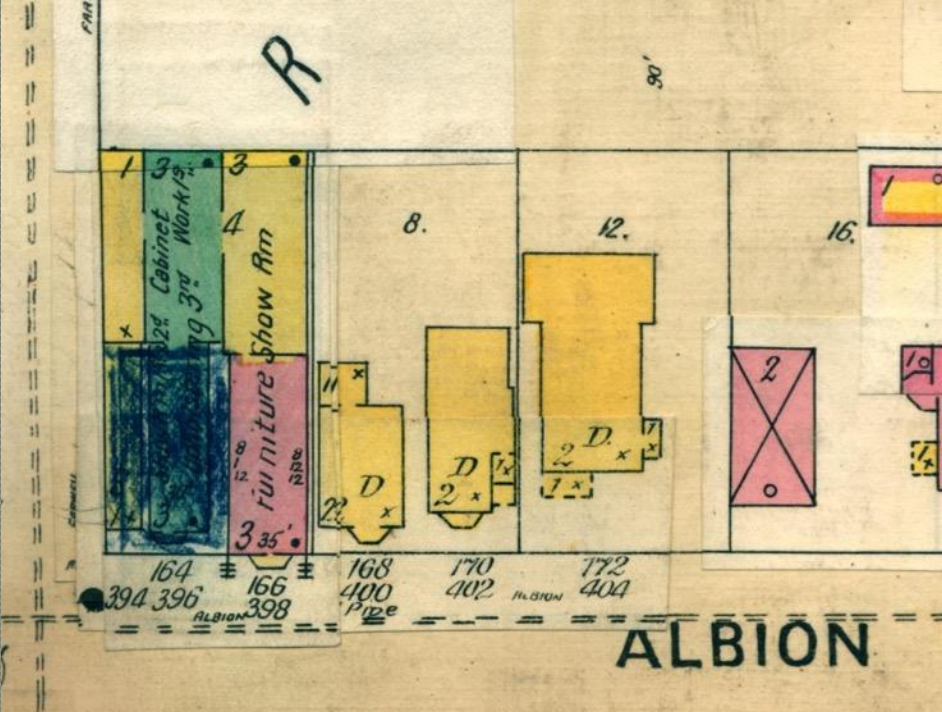

just east of the Eschweiler shop

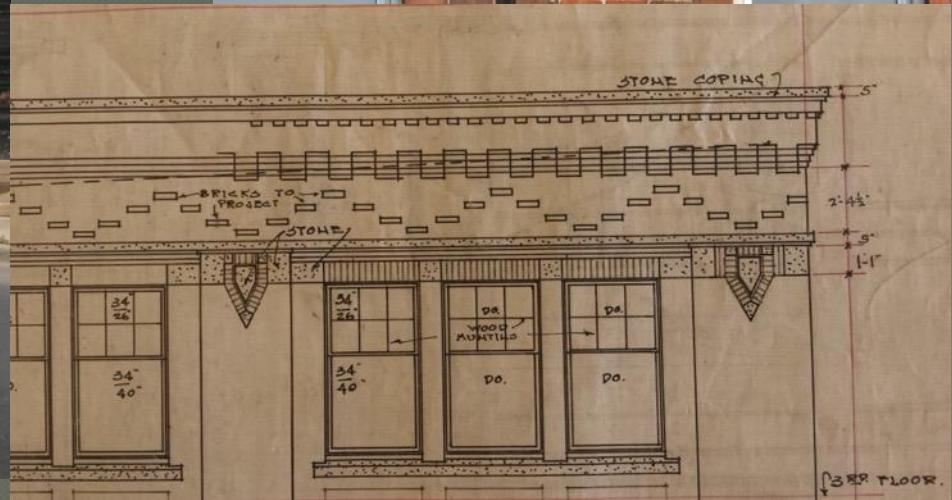





1903 masonry building constructed to the east of the wood frame shops occupied by Weise. Alexander Eschweiler was the architect



The building was expanded to the west in 1910 and the 1903 façade replaced to match the new construction.
