There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. It is the intention of the Common Council to suspend or non-renew the licenses if objectors provide testimony related to the factors enumerated in MCO 85-4-4 that the Common Council finds to be true by a preponderance of the evidence and/or police reports are found to be true by a preponderance of the evidence. The police reports and other attached documents relating to objections to the license are a part of this notice and expressly incorporated in this notice. The licensee should be prepared to address these matters at the hearing.

**Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:**

**Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.**

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 05/27/2004 the applicant was cited by Milwaukee Police Department for:

2. On 05/03/2014 a 20 year old police aide, working in conjunction with Milwaukee police, attempted to enter the Red Rock tavern at 1225 North Water Street. The police aide was challenged at the door and denied entry when she could not produce proof she was of legal drinking age.

3. On 02/19/2015 Milwaukee police conducted a tavern check at 1225 North Water Street (Redrock Saloon) and provided Timothy Casey with a packet of tavern related ordinances. They then discussed the business's procedures to prevent violations of these ordinances.
4. On 02/26/2015 a 19 year Milwaukee police aide, working in conjunction with Milwaukee police, attempted to gain entry to 1225 North Water Street (Redrock Saloon) but was turned away at the door when she could not produce proof she had attained the legal drinking age of 21.

5. On 08/07/2015 officers in District 1 conducted underage enforcement of taverns for underage drinking. An underage police aid attempted to gain entry to the Red Rock, 1225 N. Water St. She was not challenged for and ID at the door and paid the \$10 cover. Once inside she ordered and was served a Miller Lite at the bar. Tim Casey, the manager, was informed on 08/11/2015 that they failed the test.

6. On 01/23/2016 at 1:51am officers on foot patrol were flagged down by security at Red Rock, 1225 N. Water St for a fight that just occurred inside. Security was carrying out a subject they described as the primary aggressor. The subject was identified as Ronnie ROBINSON. The staff stated ROBINSON struck the victim, David PROZELLAR for an unknown reason. The staff did observe PROZELLAR antagonizing ROBINSON prior to the punch. The victim stated he did not want to prosecute for this incident.

7. On 02/04/2016 District 1 officers conducted a training course regarding the identification of fake ID's. Employees of Red Rock, 1225 N. Water St, were at the training.

8. On 03/05/2017 at 3:10am officers responded to Red Rock Saloon, 1225 N. Water St for a hazardous spill. The applicant stated that someone accidentally knocked over a bottle of cleaner in the closet that went down the drain. MFD responded and washed the area. The officers assisted with traffic control.

9. On 03/30/2017 officers conducted underage tavern enforcement in District 1. An underage Police Aid was able to gain entry to Red Rock Saloon, 1225 N. Water St. She ordered and was served a Miller Lite beer.

10. On 12/16/17 at 6:40pm, a Milwaukee Police Sergeant was flagged down by the General Manager of 1225 N. Water Street (Red Rock Saloon) for a trouble with subject complaint. Investigation revealed that a subject was escorted out of the establishment for breaking a bottle inside, became confrontational with the security staff, and later, tried to fight his girlfriend. When the Sergeant tried to arrest the subject, he became combative and refused to let the Sergeant take control of him. Security Staff from the tavern assisted the Sergeant in taking the subject into custody and used the proper amount of force to subdue the combative subject. The General Manager was quick to provide video surveillance of the incident and the subject was arrested for Felony Resisting and Misdemeanor Disorderly Conduct. The Sergeant later submitted a citizen award and letter of appreciation for the security person who helped.

11. On 01/21/18 at 2:00 am, a Milwaukee Police officer responded to 1225 N. Water Street (Red Rock Saloon) for a fight complaint. Investigation revealed that a subject stole a purse from inside the establishment and tried to leave before being stopped by the General Manager. Security and other staff were cooperative in the investigation and provided video surveillance immediately. A subject was arrested.

12. On 04/19/18 a subject walked into the First District to report his wallet was stolen from the address of 1225 N. Water Street (Red Rock Saloon) on 04/14/18. There are no suspects in the incident and contact was made to the establishment to retrieve any video surveillance of the alleged theft.

13. On 09/20/2018 officers conducted fake ID training with the serves and security staff at Red Rock Saloon. The staff was receptive to the training and were advised to call with any questions.

14. On 11/29/2018 officers conducted underage tavern enforcement in District 1 at Red Rock Saloon. The tavern passed the check.

15. On 05/26/2019 at 12:54am officers were dispatched to Red Rock Saloon, 1225 N. Water St, for a property damage complaint. The officers spoke with security who were holding a subject for standing on a table and breaking it. The subject was issued a citation.

16. On 12/10/2019 officers conducted fake ID training for staff at Red Rock Saloon, 1225 N. Water St. The training was in how to identify fake ID's. There were 15-20 staff members present.

17. On 07/16/22 at 10:36pm, Milwaukee Police conducted a license premise at 1225 N. Water Street. No violations were found and the staff was cooperative.

4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
  - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
  - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
  - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
  - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.


