This report is written by Police Officer Corstan D. COURT, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

- 1) On 08/15/95 at 11:00PM Officers passed by Taylor's located at 797 N. Jefferson St. and observed the doors open. The Officers entered the tavern, and advised the employees that the doors must be kept closed after 10:00PM. On 08/16/96 the Officers went back to Taylor's and advised the licensee Daniel Taylor about the incident on the previous night. He stated that he understood. On 08/22/96 the Officers again passed by Taylor's at 10:40PM and observed the doors open. Mr. Taylor was on the scene and became uncooperative when informed he was going to receive a citation, and asked why he was not warned regarding the offense.

**Charge:** Doors to be closed after 10:00PM  
**Finding:** Guilty  
**Sentence:** Fined \$330.00  
**Date:** 06/07/96

- 2) On 07/16/96 the Utilities and Licenses voted to recommend granting of the Class B Tavern License, and sent the applicant a warning.

Note: The applicant failed to pay the fine in regards to item #1 Case #95083832 and a warrant was issued on 08/06/96. On 08/28/96 the case was dismissed without prejudice due to a plea agreement (see item #3).

- 3) On 07/10/96 at about 11:30PM Officers observed the Southern-most door of the East side of Taylor's (797 N. Jefferson St.) propped open. The Officers observed the door standing open for about 10 minutes without anyone making an attempt to close it. The bartender John Mertins stated that he had closed the door at about 10:00PM, and that a patron must have left it open. A verbal warning had been issued on 06/25/96 regarding an open door violation. The licensee was not on the scene.

- 4) INCIDENT: On Saturday, 02/21/98 at 1:50AM Officers were dispatched to a fight at Taylors located at 797 N. Jefferson St. Upon their arrival Officers found that a fight had taken place inside the tavern between two subjects. After the initial confrontation one of the subjects exited the tavern, and was confronted by two or three other subjects. At this time another fight took place. A person who attempted to stop the fight was also struck in the face. Two subjects were issued citations for Disorderly Conduct, and One subject was issued a citation for Assault & Battery.
- 5) On Sunday, 08/02/98 at about 12:45AM Officers observed an employee hold open the front door to Taylor's tavern located at 797 N. Jefferson St. From about 12:45AM to 1:22AM the Officers monitored the tavern. At no time did the doorman close the door. At times patrons, and employees did exit and enter through the front door, however the traffic was not heavy enough to require the door being held open. At about 12:58AM the Officers observed three Males exit the tavern carrying bottles of fermented malt beverages, and a glass of fermented beverage. It did not appear that any employees made any attempt to prevent them from leaving the premise with the open bottles or glass. The three subjects continued across the street where they were stopped by Officers. The subjects admitted that they walked out of the tavern with their drinks, and no one attempted to stop them. The licensee was not on the scene, but the Officers spoke to James S. Taylor who stated he was not aware that anyone had left the premise with alcohol. He also stated that he advised the doorman to keep the front door closed. The three patrons were issued citations for public drinking.

- 6) On 06/07/99 at 10:41PM Officers observed the front door open at Taylor's tavern located at 797 N. Jefferson St. The Officer also found that one of the window/doors on the Wells St. side was open, and individuals were sitting outside drinking.

7. On 9-28-2002 at 11:50pm Milwaukee Police were sent to 795 N Jefferson to investigate a battery complaint. A Ted Barrett stated that he entered Taylor's Bar when the bouncer blocked him from entering. Barrett stated that the bouncer began pushing him out of the bar and then punched him in the face. Another patron stated that the bouncer asked Barrett for ID and that Barrett became enraged and attempted to pass by without showing any ID. When the bouncer began to escort Barrett out of the bar, Barrett punched the bouncer in the face and then the bouncer retaliated and a fight ensued. Another fight began outside the tavern between a friend of Barretts, Keye R Voight, and a person waiting in line to get in the tavern.

8. On 5-17-2003 at 9:20pm an underage Milwaukee Police Aide entered Taylors, 795 N Jefferson St. at the direction of Milwaukee Police officers. The aide was able to enter the tavern and purchase a Miller Lite beer from the bartender, Shannon C Watson, who did not ask the aide for any ID.

10. On 2-7-04, Milwaukee Police officers, along with Department of Neighborhood Services Enforcement Inspector conducted a fire inspection and license check at Taylor's, 797 North Jefferson Street. After informing the bartender of the inspection, the officers looked for, but were unable to located a posted Class B license. When they advised the bartender that the license was not posted, the bartender reached underneath the back part of the bar and handed the officers a picture frame containing the license.

11. On 6-24-06, at Taylor's, 795 N Jefferson Street, a 16 year old male, accompanied by Pastor Lee Shaw, of the City of Milwaukee Strive Tobacco Initiative, entered the premises and obtained change for a \$10.00 bill. The bartender Andrew Berra, gave the minor change and directed him downstairs to the cigarette vending machine. The licensee was not on the premises. The bartender was issued the following.

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12. On 06/18/2008 at 6:27pm, a 16-year-old subject (working in conjunction with Milwaukee Police on the Wisconsin WINS tobacco initiative) was able to purchase a pack of Newport Light brand cigarettes from the vending machine at 795 N. Jefferson (Taylor's) after obtaining change from the bartender. The bartender, Sharon Jean Collopy, was cited for Sale of Cigarettes to Minor/Underage.

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13. On 07/03/09 at 10:15 pm, Milwaukee police were dispatched to a Trouble With Subject/Theft complaint at E Lyon and N Van Buren Streets. Investigation revealed a bouncer from Taylors observed a patron stealing money from another patrons purse who then left the tavern. The bouncer, identified as Nickolas Cuda, followed the suspect along with two other bouncers and detained him until police arrived. The money was recovered and the suspect was arrested, charged and later found guilty of theft.

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14. On 12/16/10 at 12:30 am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 795 N Jefferson Street for a Battery complaint. Police spoke with the victim who stated while inside the tavern she was approached by an unknown female who was yelling profanities at her, and acting aggressively toward her, for unknown reasons. The victim stated the female then struck her in the face causing pain and discomfort. The female then left the bar and the victim followed and they fought again when the victim's cell phone fell to the ground and the female picked it up and fled the area. Witnesses did talk to police regarding this incident.

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15. On 03/29/2016 Milwaukee police were dispatched to a fight. Investigation revealed that while a patron at Taylor's Bar (795 N. Jefferson Street) the victim's wallet was removed from his pocket by two females. The victim followed the suspects to Catch 22 where he observed the suspects using his credit card to purchase drinks. The victim confronted the suspects and a fight ensued. The two suspects were arrested. Milwaukee police incident report #150880021 filed.

16. On 06/12/2015 Milwaukee police were dispatched to a battery complaint at 795 North Jefferson Street (Taylor's Bar). The victim told officers he had been punched and pushed down some stairs by an unknown assailant while a patron at the business. The victim was uncooperative with officers and stated he did not want to file a report. Milwaukee police incident report #151630010 filed.

17. On 08/07/2015 a 20 year old Milwaukee police aide, working in conjunction with Milwaukee police, attempted to gain entry to Taylor's (795 North Jefferson Street) but was turned away at the door when she could not produce proof she had attained the legal drinking age of 21.

18. On 12/12/2015 a citizen appeared at the city of Milwaukee Municipal court entrance to report a battery. The victim, Matthew Rusch, told officers he had been a patron at Taylor's (795 North Jefferson Street) with his girlfriend, Amy Schuldt, when he was approached and struck in the face by a subject, Justin Moralez, that was interested in pursuing a romantic relationship with Schuldt. Rusch was conveyed to St. Lukes hospital where he received two stitches. Milwaukee police incident report #153460027 filed.

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19. On 03/30/2017 officers conducted underage tavern enforcement in District 1. An underage Police Aid attempted to gain entry to Taylor's, 795 N. Jefferson Av. The Police Aid was denied entry at the door by security.

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20. On 03/02/2019 officers investigated a fight at Taylor's, 795 N. Jefferson. The officers spoke with the security officer who stated he was asked by the bartender to escort a patron out because he came behind the bar. As he was escorting the subject out the subject stated to fight. With the help of other patrons the security guard was able to get the subject outside, where he continued to fight. The subject stated he was fighting because the security guard never identified himself as security and he thought he was just another patron. The officers attempted to look at the surveillance cameras but were unable to view them.

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21. On 04/21/2019 at 12:30am officers responded to Taylor's, 795 N. Jefferson St for a Trouble with Subject. The officers spoke with an employee, who stated there was a subject in the business harassing him and patrons. The subject refused to leave when asked. The officers spoke with the subject, did leave but then returned. The subject was issued a citation and released.

22. On 06/11/2020 officers conducted a license premise check at Taylor's, 795 N. Jefferson St. the officers observed no violations.

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23. On 12/19/20 at 1:50am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 795 N. Jefferson Street for a fight complaint. Investigation revealed that three subject were involved in a fight which resulted in one receiving a citation. Witnesses state that the fight was observed by security and the owner of the establishment. Security was able to give an account of the incident but the owner, who appeared to be intoxicated, told officers that he did not see the incident and none of the surveillance cameras in his establishment are working. Officers observed numerous tavern violations which include, numerous patrons inside the tavern after 2:30am and a bartender serving drinks to patrons after 2:30am.

24. On 02/25/21 at 8:54pm, Milwaukee Police conducted a license premise check at 795 N. Jefferson Street. The manager was cooperative with officers and no tavern violations were observed at the time of the contact.

## Narrative (1)

### INVESTIGATION

Baczok, Jacob E 018522

12/19/2020

This report is written by P.O. Jacob BACZEK, assigned to District 1, POWER SHIFT.

On Saturday, December 19th, 2020, while working on squad 1420, Myself and P.O. Richard MICHALAK were advised of a disturbance/fight at Taylor's Bar located at 795 North Water Street. Upon arrival, I spoke to Walter J. HOLTZ (w/m 05-30-66) who stated that he is a frequent patron of the establishment. HOLTZ stated that he observed a w/m who was intoxicated accidentally bump into him. HOLTZ stated the subject became aggressive and waived a finger in his face. HOLTZ stated that he pushed the subject's finger out of his face at which time he was sucker punched by a male, later identified as Todd K. DORO (w/m 04-12-73), the intoxicated male's father. HOLTZ had a bloody nose, and stated that DORO's actions caused him pain.

I then asked the owner James TAYLOR if I would be able to review the incident either immediately or in the evening when I returned to work. TAYLOR stated that none of the cameras in his establishment are functioning even though a security guard at the location stated there were functioning cameras at the location. TAYLOR also appeared to have slurred speech and appeared to be intoxicated and stated he did not witness anything, which contradict what HOLTZ stated, that TAYLOR observed the incident. TAYLOR stated he just wanted everyone to leave and did not want any police action taken at his establishment. I then informed TAYLOR that a license premise report would be filed regarding this incident in his establishment.

I interviewed the security that was standing at the door and spoke to Luke R. NYBERG (w/m 04-14-83), who stated that he was working security and he heard some yelling over in the side bar area. He looked up and saw a subject waiving a finger in the face of HOLTZ, and saw HOLTZ push the subject's hand away from his face. NYBERG then observed DORO begin throwing punches in the direction of HOLTZ and then observed HOLTZ to have a bloody nose.

P.O. MICHALAK then attempted to interview DORO who was evasive and did not want to cooperate with the investigation. DORO was issued a citation for battery, MPD# 0683BDBC3M.

I then observed during our investigation several tavern violations that were unable to be addressed at the time. There were numerous patrons inside the tavern past 2:30 a.m. I also observed a female bartender serving drinks past 2:30 a.m. I informed TAYLOR that he has several tavern violations at the time and these would be listed in the tavern report as well.

Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

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## Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
2. You must testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
  - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
  - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
  - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
  - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.


