Attached please find a Stipulation an Order and Proposed Resolution authorizing a new study of the actual costs to provide voter poll list.

The above caption matter filed by Mr. James McCann and Targeted Voters System, Inc. against the Milwaukee City Board of Election Commissioners and Ms. Julietta Henry, Executive Director of the Milwaukee City Board of Election Commissioners. The nature of the action challenged the current rate set for obtaining voters poll lists from the Election Commission.

In light of the fact that the Milwaukee City Board of Election Commissioners has recently obtained new computerized equipment, the current rate for voter poll lists in § 81.48 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances.

The purpose of this study will be to conduct a complete study of the actual cost of providing such voter poll list, and based upon the results of such study, to adjust the rates currently set forth in § 81.48 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances.
