File # 021302 is a resolution relative to application, acceptance and funding of a Beat Patrol Program Grant.

#### Background

- 1. This resolution authorizes the Milwaukee Police Department (MPD) to apply for, accept and fund a Beat Patrol Program from the State of Wisconsin, Office of Justice Assistance.
- 2. This grant is continuing.

### **Discussion**

- 1. The purpose of the Beat Patrol program is to work with neighborhood residents to identify and resolve crime and quality of life issues that impact upon the local area.
- 2. This grant funds 6 existing full time Police Officer positions with salary and fringe benefits for this program within the MPD 2<sup>nd</sup> District.
- 3. This grant encompasses the period of January 1, 2003 through December 31, 2003.

## Fiscal Impact

- 1. The total amount of this grant is \$522,864 with \$150,000 provided by the grantor and \$372,864 provided by the city. The city share includes indirect costs (\$147,848) associated with grant administration.
- 2. The city portion of this grant is included in the 2003 MPD operations budget.
