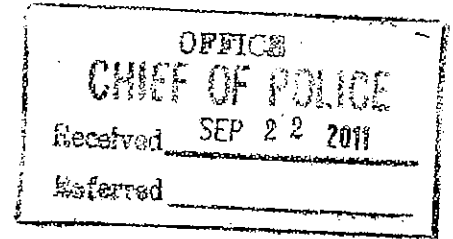
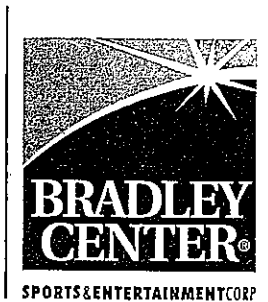
We appreciate this partnership and look forward to continuing our efforts to provide a safe environment in downtown Milwaukee.
