This is to notify you that on Tuesday, March 27, 2001, the City's Utilities and Licenses Committee voted to recommend to the City's Common Council that your application for a Cabaret license for the premises at 2758 S. 35<sup>th</sup> Street ("Top Prospects Sports Bar & Grill") be granted to allow Comedy acts and Live Musicians but not to allow "floor shows" and "patron contests". The Committee made such a recommendation based upon the following:

The health, safety and welfare of the neighborhood will be impaired by the granting of an alcohol beverage license for this location that permitted "floor shows" and "patron contests".

On Tuesday, April 10, 2001, the Common Council considered the Committee's recommendation regarding your application. On that date, the Common Council adopted the Committee's recommendation and granted your application with the above restrictions.
