Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. **Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:**

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

Bankhead said a man named "Mario" attacked her and her friends and that she believed "Mario" worked there. Officers spoke to the applicant who told them that he was not aware of any employees or regulars of the business named "Mario". Milwaukee police incident report #141260018 filed.
4. On 06/06/2014 Milwaukee police responded to a sexual assault complaint at 4132 North 24<sup>th</sup> Place. The victim, Shayevon Blue-Craig, told officers she had been sexually assaulted in the bathroom at her place of employment, C Notes Upscale Sports Lounge (5138 North 37<sup>th</sup> Street). The victim was conveyed to her mother's home following this incident and was then conveyed by ambulance to Mount Sinai Hospital. Milwaukee police incident report #141570024 filed.

This report is written by P.O. Dean LIDWIN, assigned to District 7, late shift.

On May 6, 2014, at 3:37 AM, squad 7330, myself, responded to Mt Sinai HOSPITAL for a battery complaint.

When I arrived, I spoke to the victim, Ariana M BANKHEAD, b/f, 06-09-91, who said she arrived with some friends at the tavern at about 12:45 AM. She said she had never been there before, and thinks none of her friends had been either. BANKHEAD said there was an argument that happened inside the tavern that escalated to outside the building.

BANKHEAD said that a man, who she said, "seemed like he worked there," attacked her and her friends, battering her and another female. BANKHEAD said the man, who said he was "Mario" punched her in the face numerous times, and pushed into a chainlink fence. During the incident, BANKHEAD sustained a laceration to her left eye that required stitches. When I was done with BANKHEAD at the hospital, I went to the scene, 5138 N 37<sup>th</sup> St to investigate further. By this time of day it was after 05:00 and the bar was closed.

I went back to the bar two times in the next two days to attempt to speak with someone there but both days it was closed. On Monday, May 12, 2014, I found the bar to be open and I spoke with the owner Cedric R HORTON, b/m, 08-02-74, who said he was there the night of the incident. He said he did not know there was a fight outside the bar. He also said the security system he has in place saves video footage for a period of 4-5 days, and then purges it from the system. He said there would be no footage of the incident. I asked him if there was anyone working for him, or regular customers that call themselves "Mario." HORTON said no one that he knows goes by the name "Mario" at his tavern. HORTON was cooperative, and told me the police are welcome anytime in his business.

NARRATIVE SECTION: INC # 14-157-0024 Investigative Report Filed by Detective Steven Delie

This report is being submitted by P.O. Micolette ACEVEDO, assigned to District 7, Late Shift.

On Friday, June 6th, 2014, while assigned squad 7330, I was dispatched to 4132 N. 24th Pl. regarding a sexual assault complaint. This incident occurred in the city and county of Milwaukee, Wisconsin, on Friday, June 6th, 2014, at C Notes Upscale Sports Lounge located at 5138 N. 37th Street, at approximately 01:10 A.M.

Upon my arrival on scene, I observed the victim, Shayeon Y. BLUE-CRAIG (B/F, 08/28/93, of 9091 N. 76th Street Apt. #601 (414)388-2938) being carried in a stretcher to Medicare Ambulance 208. BLUE-CRAIG appeared to be highly intoxicated, was crying and had slurred speech.

Interview of Janel A. CRAIG

I spoke with BLUE-CRAIG's mother, Janel A. CRAIG (B/F, 02/14/74, of 4132 N, 24th Pl. (414)316-7146) CRAIG stated that BLUE-CRAIG was driven to her residence by a close family friend, identified as . BLUE-CRAIG was highly intoxicated and stated that she had been raped at work, C Notes, where she is a dancer. BLUE-CRAIG informed CRAIG that BLUE-CRAIG was taken into a bathroom, where a male subject by the initials of M.D. sexually assaulted BLUE CRAIG. CRAIG stated that the suspect entered his telephone number, (802)279-9956 under the name of M.D., into BLUE-CRAIG's cellular phone. CRAIG then called the police.

Interview of Jerrell A. WASHINGTON

I spoke with Jerrell A. WASHINGTON (B/M, 09/10/86, of 3570 N. Teutonia Ave (414) 499-0483) WASHINGTON identified himself as a close friend of BLUE-CRAIG's family. WASHINGTON stated that on 06/06/14, at approximately 01:21, he received a phone call from BLUE-CRAIG, asking him to pick her up from work. When WASHINGTON arrived at C Notes, he was met by the suspect who informed him that she had just been raped by a subject in a red t-shirt. WASHINGTON was then approached by a female bartender, informed WASHINGTON that BLUE-CRAIG had been drinking very heavily prior to his arrival, and that her accusations were false. WASHINGTON then conveyed BLUE-CRAIG to her mother's residence.

Interview of Shayeon Y. BLUE-CRAIG

I spoke with BLUE-CRAIG who stated that on 06/06/14, at approximately 01:00 A.M., she had become highly intoxicated at her place of employment, C Notes Upscale Sports Lounge. BLUE-CRAIG informed staff that she was going home and called for a ride. While waiting, BLUE-CRAIG, was taken back inside the lounge and guided into the bathroom by a suspect identified as M.D. (B/M, 25-30 YOA 506-507, 160 lbs, dark complexion, mustache and beard, red t-shirt, blue jeans, unknown shoes, or hair, unkn color snap back baseball cap. (802)279-9956. M.D. proceeded to pull BLUE-CRAIG's pants down without the victim's consent and performed penis to vagina sexual intercourse. BLUE-CRAIG stated that she was too intoxicated to scream for help. When M.D. left the restroom, an unknwon bartender entered to notify her that her ride had arrived. BLUE-CRAIG stated that she had been raped, however, no one believed her due to her high level of intoxicicated. BLUE-CRAIG was conveyed to 4132 N. 24<sup>th</sup> Pl. where her mother resides. BLUE-CRAIG was conveyed to Mt. Sinai Hospital located at 945 N. 12th Street for further evaluation by Medicare 208 at approximately 02:56 A.M. She was admitted at approximately 03:12 A.M. and treated by Dr. Toula LAZARIDES.

On Friday, March 20, 2015 PO Travis CAPELLE and I, PO Tiara SHEETS-WALKER, were assigned to District 7, Late Power Shift.

At approximately 12:02am on March 21, 2015 we were dispatched to 5138 N 37<sup>th</sup> Street C-Notes Sport's Lounge for a shooting complaint. Upon arrival, I observed victim Kevin E. WHATLEY B/M 2/13/86 lying on the ground in front of C-Notes Sport Lounge with three gunshot wounds. WHATLEY had a gunshot wound in the face near the right of his nose, a gunshot wound to the right hand and one gunshot wound to his left upper thigh area. The unknown subject that shot the victim was inside of C-Note Sport's Lounge along with WHATLEY. The unknown subject exited the bar after WHATLEY and they began a verbal altercation that led to a fight. Unknown subject then shot WHATLEY three times and fled the scene. Video footage from the bar captures the incident of the shooting.

A full count of patrons and employees as they sat inside of the building revealed a total of 7 people. Video system was operating and the incident was recorded.

### Phase 1

#### Observations outside the location

#### VEHICLES:

Vehicles were parked on the roadway in front of the business, as C-Note's Sports Lounge does not have a parking lot. All vehicles, but one were accounted for by PO VALUCH.

#### CITIZENS:

The victim WHATLEY was the only person located outside of the tavern during this investigation.

#### SECURITY AND DOOR COUNT:

There was a security officer, Darius T. TOLIVER M/B 9/30/89, working at the front door, but he did not know the current occupancy and he did not know what the occupancy limit was.

#### EXTERNAL SIGNAGE:

No external signage was observed during this investigation.

The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place on 5/14/2015 at 11:00 AM, in Room 301-B, Third Floor, City Hall. If you wish, you may provide testimony at the hearing regarding the request; see below for further information. You are not required to attend the hearing. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing. Please review the information below and if you have further questions regarding this process, please contact the License Division at (414) 286-2238.

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## Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
  - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
  - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
