Security Comments: The licensee does not plan on having any security at this time.

ADDITIONAL COMMENTS/RECOMMENDATIONS:

1. It is recommended that the licensee affix two cameras on the side of the building that faces the parking lot, one facing north and one facing south. It is noted that this parking lot does not

belong to this business at this point, however many patrons of this establishment do use this parking lot.

2. It is recommended that the licensee affix two cameras on the front of the building, one facing west and one facing east, as to capture the sidewalk, patio area and West Vliet St.
3. It is recommended that the licensee affix at least two "No loitering" signs on the side of the building that faces the parking lot.
4. Once the Class "B" tavern license is issued, it is recommended that all employee's obtain a Class "D" Operators license as to avoid any violations relating to unlicensed person(s) operating at the location. However prior to obtaining this license, the employee would first have to complete a Wisconsin Responsible Beverage Server Course which will teach the employees how to responsibly sell and serve alcoholic beverages.
5. It is recommended that rules regarding the expected behavior of patrons on the patio area of the premises be clearly stated within the business. The patio is located in the front of the business between the public sidewalk and structure. This area consists of three tables with two chairs at each.
6. After obtaining a Class "B" license, the licensee plans to offer patrons, in addition to the coffee menu items, a limited selection of wines and beer as well as a "coffee" cocktails. In addition to the Class "B" license, the licensee has applied for a Public Entertainment Premises license, which will be limited to "Instrumental musicians".
7. According to the businesses plan of operation, the licensee plans on offering small plate food items such as charcuterie and cheese, various spreads and fresh bread from local bakeries. Prior to doing this, the licensee shall apply and obtain a Food Dealers license with the City of Milwaukee.
8. It should be noted that the licensee and/or business partner are in the process of purchasing the building as well as the parking lot.
