This is to notify you that on Monday, September 20, 2010, the Licenses Committee voted to recommend to the Common Council that the applications for Class "B" Tavern and Tavern Amusement (Cabaret/Nite Club) licenses for the premises at 730 N. Old World Thirs St. ("Silk East") be denied. The Committee made such a recommendation based upon neighborhood testimony concerning factors detrimental to the health, safety and welfare of the neighborhood.

On Tuesday, September 21, 2010, the Common Council considered the Committee's recommendation regarding your applications. On that date, the Council adopted the Committee's recommendation and denied your applications.
