## Dear Council Members:

Reconstruction of the Marquette Interchange will include modifications to local streets. Due to the magnitude of this project, it is being divided into phases. These phases are known as the North 11<sup>th</sup> Street Contract, which will affect North 11<sup>th</sup> Street from West Wells Street to West Highland Avenue, and the Tory Hill Contract, which will affect West Tory Hill from North 9<sup>th</sup> Street to North 11<sup>th</sup> Street.

Street lighting work being done in conjunction with this project will include the installation of permanent lighting improvements. Funding for the street lighting work is provided by the Wiscons in Department of Transportation (WISDOT) by means of a Local Force Account.

One hundred percent of the total cost will be funded by WISDOT.

The attached resolution authorizes and directs the Commissioner of Public Works to execute a Local Force Account with WISDOT that allows City forces to install permanent lighting on North 11<sup>th</sup> Street from West Wells Street to West Highland Avenue, and on West Tory Hill from North 9<sup>th</sup> Street to North 11<sup>th</sup> Street.
