To Whom It May Concern:

I am a Detective with the Milwaukee Police Department. I work out of District 7, which is located at 3626 W. Fond du Lac Avenue and as such park my personal vehicle on the employee parking lot on the west side of the building. At approximately 3:45 P.M. on 04-01-05, I parked my car on the employee lot next to the fence that runs north/south. I observed a freestanding basketball hoop lying on the ground parallel to the fence. This basketball hoop had been brought to the District station for disposal and had been on the lot for several days awaiting garbage pick-up.

At approximately 1:00 A.M. on 04-02-05, while still on duty, I was alerted by a Department member that my personal car had been damaged while parked on the lot. Some unknown person entered the employee only parking lot, picked up the basketball hoop from where it was lying and dropped it on my car. The base of the basketball hoop was wedged against the passenger door with the pole coming to rest on the trunk causing damage. I immediately notified the District supervisor as well as my own supervisor and a police report was filed (Incident 05-092-0024). In addition, photos were taken of the damages. I have enclosed a copy of that report as well as the photos for your review.

After this incident occurred I had spoken with Sergeant Ivory Britton of District 7 day shift who stated that he was aware of the basketball hoop being brought to the District lot a few days earlier. He stated that the City was notified to pick up the hoop the following day but for some reason they didn't.

I feel that the City was negligent in the failure to remove the basketball hoop from the lot in a timely manner. In addition I think negligence was shown by the simple fact that this hoop was placed out in the lot without being somewhat disassembled. If this was not possible, the basketball hoop should have remained in the closed garage until pick-up arrived.

I have obtained and enclosed two itemized estimates for the repairs to my vehicle as a result of this incident. I am requesting the lower amount of the two estimates (\$1,132.03) for the damages to my vehicle.
