On West Highland Avenue, there is one westbound lane at the traffic signal at the intersection of North 8th Street. When westbound vehicles turn left at the intersection and are unable to clear because of oncoming traffic, all westbound vehicles are blocked causing traffic to back up, reducing safety, and increasing congestion. Therefore, we recommend the installation of no parking anytime on the north side of West Highland Avenue from North 8th Street to a point 85 feet east to allow westbound through traffic to pass westbound left-turning vehicles that are stopped for oncoming traffic at the intersection.
