There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

D - Overall level of cooperation: has client complied with referrals and services designed to address criminogenic needs Yes.



8. On 09/25/25, at 10:00 a.m., the applicant was found guilty in Kenosha County Circuit Court of Bail Jumping. Case 2025FO001101.
9. The applicant is currently on Probation. On 12/15/25, at 7:47 a.m., an email was sent to the Department of Correction requesting they provide the License Division information regarding the probation status and any opposition on granting a license.

On Monday, April 7, 2025, at 6:39PM, I was conducting Tobacco Compliance Checks with Wisconsin Win Program with two Milwaukee Public Safety cadets. We went to Clark gas station at ~~2000~~ N. Prospect Av. 2200- per CAD in the City and County of Milwaukee.

At 6:42 pm, Syntrell went into Clark gas station. The white male clerk sold SYNTRELL 1 grape swisher. The male clerk did not asked SYNTRELL for ID and he paid \$2.60. SYNTRELL stated the clerk looked in his 40's, 5'9, slim build, wearing light green baseball cap, black graphic t-shirt and khaki pants.

I went into the store and I observed a white male, light green baseball cap, black graphic t-shirt and khaki pants behind the counter. I stated that he sold tobacco to a minor and he said no he did not. The male clerk stated that I set him up; he refused to give me his name but gave me the owner name and phone number. He stated he would sell again. I explain how important it is to check ID's and do not sell to minors. The business licenses are up to date and the owner will received a citation.

You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
 - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
 - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
 - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
 - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.
Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
