Subject: Ordinance Review for Habitual Parking Violators & Possible Amendment

Hello Mr. Owczarski,

The ordinance, as originally drafted, is legal and enforceable. It mirrors the enabling statute's requirements for the creation of an ordinance for the removal and disposal of vehicles owned by habitual parking violators. *See generally*, Wis. Stat. sec. 349.139.

The possible amendment to the ordinance is not required by Wis. Stat. sec. 349.139(2). Additionally, it is unclear how the information will be collected, from what sources, how the information will be retained, and there may be privacy concerns. It may also create compliance concerns with the federal Driver's Privacy Protection Act (DPPA). My recommendation is to reject its inclusion in the proposed ordinance.
