This is in response to a request from a local resident to install the above-captioned parking restriction.

Our traffic engineering staff has investigated this request and found southbound motorists on North 15th Street have a difficult time seeing traffic traveling westbound on West State Street when vehicles park close to the corner. Therefore, in the interest of public safety, we recommend installing this restriction to increase cross traffic visibility at the intersection.

We will prepare the necessary legislation for the next Public Safety Committee meeting, so that you may support it to final passage.
