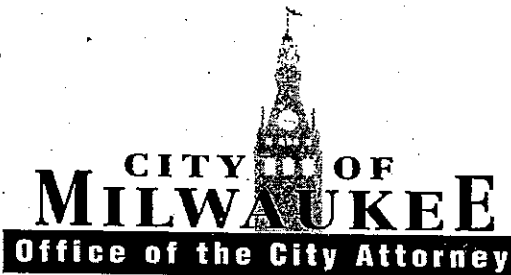

We have received your claim in the amount of \$2,875.00, relating to damage sustained on May 31, 2007 when the police made forced entry into the property located at 3825 North 50th Street.

Our investigation reveals that the police undertook necessary and appropriate action relative to a request to check on the welfare of an occupant of the building. Since the police were not negligent in this matter, the City would not be liable. Therefore, we are denying your claim.
