**Regarding:** Your Class B Tavern, Food Dealer, and Public Entertainment Premises License Applications Requesting Concerts, Karaoke, Patrons Dancing, Bands, Poetry Readings, Disc Jockey, and Instrumental Musicians as agent for "Curry Goat Corp" for "Jewels Caribbean Restaurant" at 2230 N Martin L King Jr DR.

There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-2.7-4, probative evidence concerning whether or not a new license should be granted may be presented on the following subjects: whether or not the applicant meets the municipal requirements, the appropriateness of the location and premises where the licensed premises is to be located and whether use of the premises for the purposes or activities permitted by the license would tend to facilitate a public or private nuisance or create undesirable neighborhood problems such as disorderly patrons, unreasonably loud noise, litter, and excessive traffic and parking congestion. Probative evidence relating to these matters may be taken from the plan of operation submitted with the license application, if any, but shall not include the content of any music. Evidence regarding the fitness of the location of the premises to be maintained as the principal place of business, including but not limited to whether there is an overconcentration of businesses of the type for which the license is sought; whether the proposal is consistent with any pertinent neighborhood business or development plans, or the location's proximity to areas where children are typically present. The applicant's record in operating similarly licensed premises; and whether or not the applicant has been charged with or convicted of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the activity to be permitted by the license being applied for or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety or welfare may also be considered. See attached police report or correspondence.

**Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:** Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

Limited parking for persons attending meetings in City Hall is available at reduced rates (5 hour limit) at the Milwaukee Center on the southwest corner of East Kilbourn and North Water Street. Parking tickets must be validated in the first floor information booth in City Hall.

**ADDITIONAL COMMENTS/RECOMMENDATIONS:**

This supplemental report is written by P.O. Laurel Lammers, assigned to District Five on the early power shift as the Community Liaison Officer. On Monday, October 9<sup>th</sup>, 2017 at 2 pm, I met with the applicant, Mrs. Lucile Jules, at the District Five police station. Mrs. Jules has not yet purchased the building at 2230 N. Martin Luther King Jr Dr., but does plan to open a restaurant at that location.

We did have a very good dialog about various safety measures she can employ for a safe business. She stated that she plans on having security cameras on the interior and exterior of the building. I did state that when they were closer to opening, we could come out to the location and provide suggestions on where to best place the cameras. I did also recommend that whatever system they purchase, to have it record for 30 days, and to make sure all employees know how to work the system. I did suggest to Mrs. Jules to have a safe inside of the business so they can keep the register drawers low in cash. Mrs. Jules stated that she would also like to have on site security through a licensed and bonded company. She also would like to put in place a dress code and use a metal detector wand.

I did provide to her the phone number to schedule Robbery Prevention Training through the Community Outreach and Education Division. I did also provide a district contact guide.

The above application has been made by the above named applicant(s). This requires approval from the Licenses Committee and the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee. The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place on 1/3/2018 at 10:15 AM, in Room 301-B, Third Floor, City Hall. If you wish, you may provide testimony at the hearing regarding the request; see below for further information. You are not required to attend the hearing. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing. Please review the information below and if you have further questions regarding this process, please contact the License Division at (414) 286-2238.

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## Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
  - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
  - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
  - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
  - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.  
**Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.**

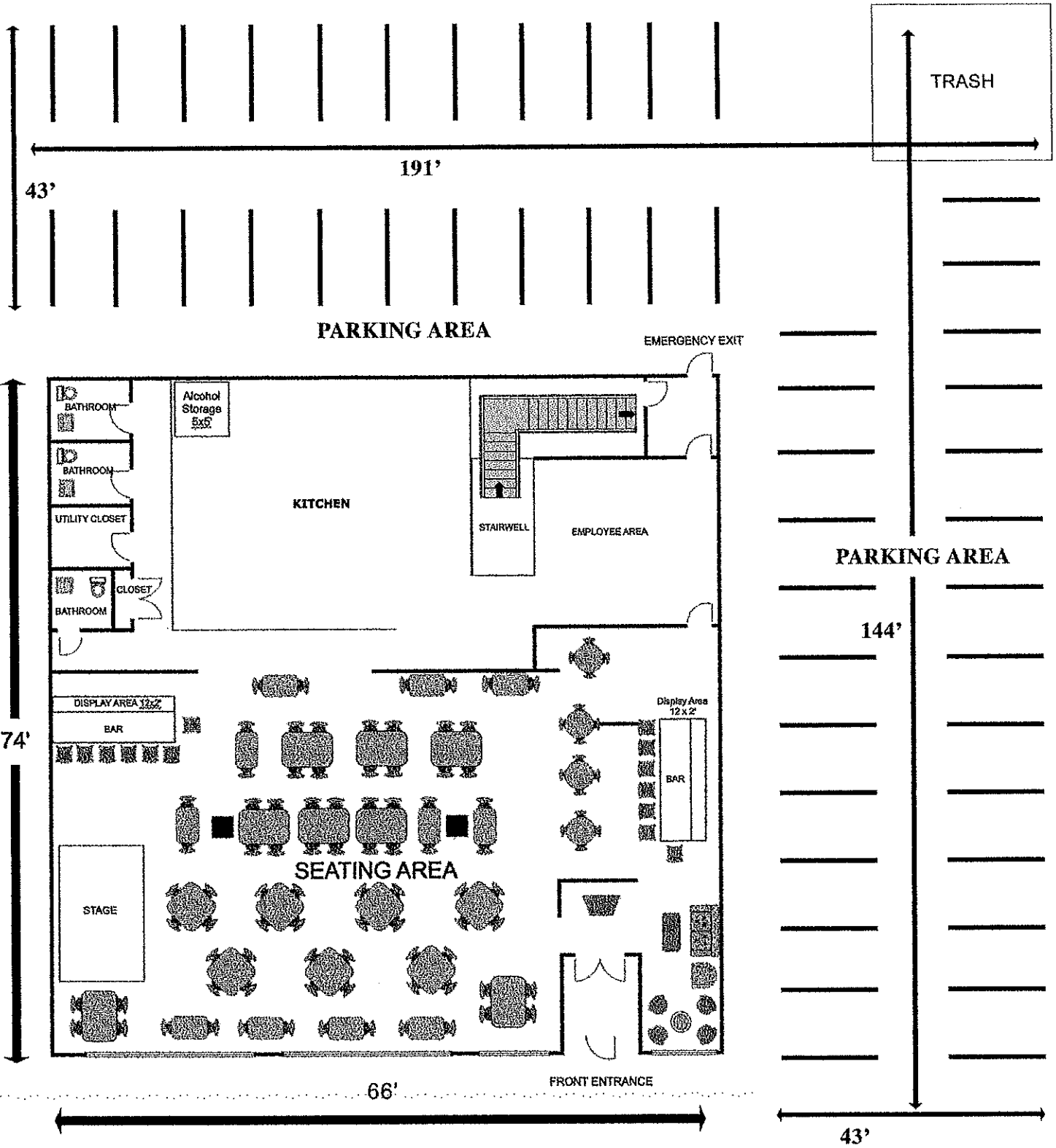

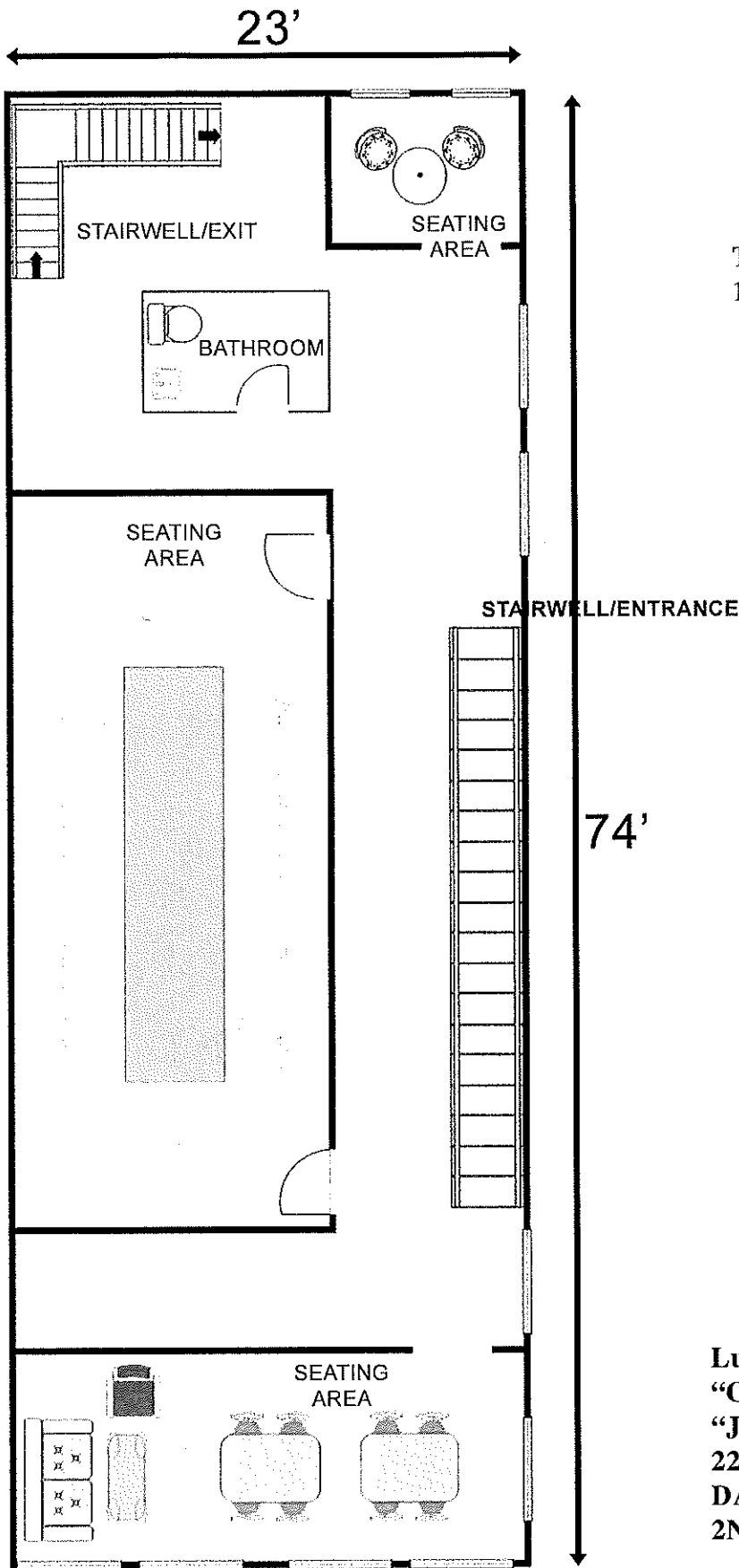

At approximately 1:40am, PO KULENOVIC and I responded to a Shotspotter in the 3500 block of North 19th Street which was related to this incident.

At approximately 2:30am, while checking the area for the suspect, PO KULENOVIC and I were dispatched to Tha Competition bar, located at 3621 North Teutonia Ave, to check for possible video evidence relating to this incident. Upon arrival at the bar, we were met by Detective Daniel PRIEWE, assigned to Squad 9348. We were met at the door by the bar's owner, Isaiah F WALLS (B/M, 05/25/89), who allowed us to view the bar's video surveillance system.

At approximately 2:40am, Forensic Investigator Paul CERVERA, assigned to Squad 1920, responded to Tha Competition bar to retrieve the bar's video surveillance. At approximately 3:08am, Detective PRIEWE instructed PO KULENOVIC and I to continue to view the bar's video surveillance while Forensic Investigator CERVERA and Detective PRIEWE respond to the scene at 3526 North 19th Street to collect evidence relating to this incident.

At approximately 4:00am, WALLS informed me that he could no longer wait on scene due to having a pregnant girlfriend at home. WALLS stated to me that he would be willing to come into the bar early on Saturday, 04/22/17, to meet with detectives so that the bar's video surveillance footage could be downloaded. This report is written by PO David LETTEER, assigned to District 5, Power Shift Tavern Squad 5469. On 04-23-17, PO Jeff KENNEDY and I responded to the call for more squads at the location of 3621 N. Teutonia Ave., Tha Competition Sports Bar.

Upon arrival, I observed Det. Joseph SEDLACEK, Squad 9359, standing in front of Tha Competition Sports Bar, attempting to speak with Justin FORNEY (b/m 03-18-80). Justin is the brother of the licensee/agent Isaiah F. WALLS (b/m 05-25-89). Det. SELACEK was attempting to get video footage of people that were in the bar the night before, in regards to a shooting that occurred, near the bar (IR 17-112-0010). FORNEY appeared agitated and was raising his voice at the detective, telling him that they were busy and that the police were not getting any video at this time, due to this being their busiest time. He stated that the police could come back later after bar close and retrieve the video, due to him and Isaiah being at the bar until 4:00 a.m.

I informed Det. SEDLACEK that FORNEY is not the licensee/agent, but WALLS is and we should talk to him, not FORNEY. I entered the bar and attempted to speak to WALLS regarding getting the video.

WALLS, stated last night, the night of the incident, he was at the bar and was cooperating with the officer's attempts to get the video. WALLS stated he received a call from his girlfriend, who is pregnant. He stated she needed him at home, so he left, telling the police to come back tomorrow. WALLS stated in his girlfriend's current condition, when she calls, he goes home. WALLS stated he told the officers to come back the next night in order to retrieve the video.

WALLS stated that earlier in the day he received a phone call from the detectives regarding coming back to get the video. He stated he missed the call and called the detectives back, but did not get a phone call back. WALLS stated he came to the bar and opened as normal. He stated the detectives came in at or about midnight and wanted the video. WALLS stated he was not going to get the video, due to the time they came. WALLS stated it was peak business time for the bar and he could not get the video due to the amount of business. WALLS stated the detectives came into the bar demanding the video and he did not appreciate how they spoke to him, in order to get the video. After speaking to WALLS for a few minutes, I asked him if he would get the video for me, being the tavern car. WALLS stated he would not, due the way the detectives were at the bar. WALLS eventually agreed to get the video after the bar closed at 2:30 a.m. and there were no more customers in the bar. PO MACRAE arrived at the bar. He and I remained in the bar until bar closing. At 2:30 a.m., bar close, WALLS attempted to get the information the detectives were looking for, which was contained on his video system.

WALLS attempted to gain access to the DVR video system, which was working while the bar was open. During the course of trying to get the video, the DVR control box turned off and could not be turned back on. Det. SEDLACK asked if the DVR box could be taken, in order to get the evidence that was on the DVR. WALLS and FORNEY both said they did not want the DVR box taken. FORNEY went on to state that the DVR recorder was the heart of the business. He stated that if something happens at the bar, they would not have anything to record the incident inside or outside of the bar.

The detectives informed WALLS and FORNEY that a search warrant was going to be applied for and the DVR box would be seized with a warrant, due to the evidence contained on the DVR. WALLS would not consent to giving the DVR box to the detectives and informed the detectives to get a warrant. Officer's remained at the bar until the warrant was issued and executed to WALLS. The DVR system was eventually placed on inventory. While at the bar, WALLS did help in getting a download of id's that were scanned into their id machine during the course of the night of the incident being investigated.



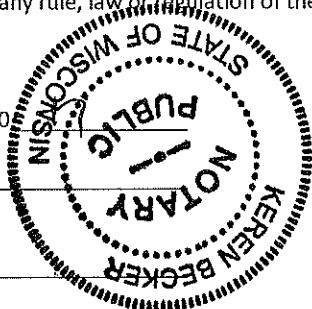
