This office is in receipt of your claim in the amount of \$633.60, relating to water in your basement on October 13, 2001 allegedly due to a plugged City sewer at 2770 North 54th Street.

Our investigation reveals that the sewer in question was on a three year cleaning schedule. The last time the sewer was cleaned was on October 13, 2000. Because the sewer was on a regular cleaning schedule and the City of Milwaukee did not have any notice of any problems with the sewer, the City cannot be held liable. Accordingly, we are denying your claim.
