

Re: Written objection to the March 9, 2004 report of the Utilities and Licenses Committee.

Common Council Members:

I, Frank L. Winston, object to the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law concerning the renewal application for a Class 'B' Tavern and Tavern Dance license for the premises located at 2691 S. 6th St. (Cleveland's Lounge).

These findings conclude that I be issued a fifteen day suspension beginning midnight, April 9, 2004.

I object to this conclusion based on the fact that I have never been in trouble with the police before this particular incident and in fact had developed a very good rapport with the police officers in my district. In addition I have never had a reason to appear before the Common Council in regards to any situation of this nature.

I feel that the actions of my employee were justified and in the best interest of the business's patrons at that time. And I believe that an injustice has been committed by the Licensing Committee's recommendation, therefore I am protesting this action.
