Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition attend the virtual hearing and are willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. 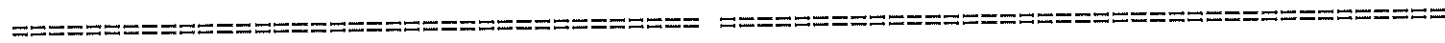

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 09/20/16 the applicant was cited in Jefferson County with Disorderly Conduct.

2. On 03/27/20 Milwaukee Police received information regarding tow trucks taking parts off vehicles prior to towing. One of the tow trucks was identified as belonging to Diamond Towing. The officer spoke to the agent who admitted taking catalytic converters off prior to towing to make more money. The agent was advised it was illegal to dismantle vehicles prior to towing. The agent was cooperative and apologized.
3. On 03/23/21 Milwaukee Police received information from West Allis Police regarding stolen catalytic converters being sold to Diamond Start Towing. The officer spoke to the owner, who admitted to buying the parts, but was not aware of the requirements in Chapter 93. The owner was further advised that he would need to Salvage to his license to remove catalytic converters prior to junking vehicles. The owner was cooperative and stated he would amend his application to include Salvage.

I received an email, from P.O. Gerald Kraker, regarding CAD #200871159. The complainant/caller, Dean E Holzmann (w/m-07/13/89), who is the owner at K & M Tires at 6550 N 40th, called police to complain of the dismantling of vehicle parts on the street.

I spoke with Holzmann who told me tow trucks stop in front of his business, on the street and take catalytic converters and other vehicle parts off of the vehicles before towing the vehicle to Wrench N Go (3520 W Mill Rd) for junking.

Holzmann took the me the business name on the white with green tow truck was "Diamond Towing".

I called the agent for Diamond Towing, Brandon Rick, who was cooperative.

Rick told me he does not tow a lot of vehicles, but he does remember towing to Wrench N Go on 03/27/20. Rick told me Wrench N Go told him to take the catalytic converter off the vehicle, to make more money, so Rick took the vehicle to 6551 N 40 St and did dismantle some parts off the vehicle. I told Rick it was illegal to dismantle on our streets. Rick said he did not know and would not do it again.

I gave Rick a verbal warning.

The above application has been made by the above named applicant(s). This requires approval from the Licenses Committee and the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee. The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place virtually on 9/8/2021 at 9:05 AM. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to view the proceeding are able to do so via the City Channel – Channel 25 on Spectrum Cable – or on the Internet at <http://city.milwaukee.gov/citychannel>. Those wishing to provide oral testimony will be asked to do so by phone or internet and are asked to contact the staff assistant, Molly Kuether-Steele at (414) 286-2775 or molly.kuether-steele@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
2. You must testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
 - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
 - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
 - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
 - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.


