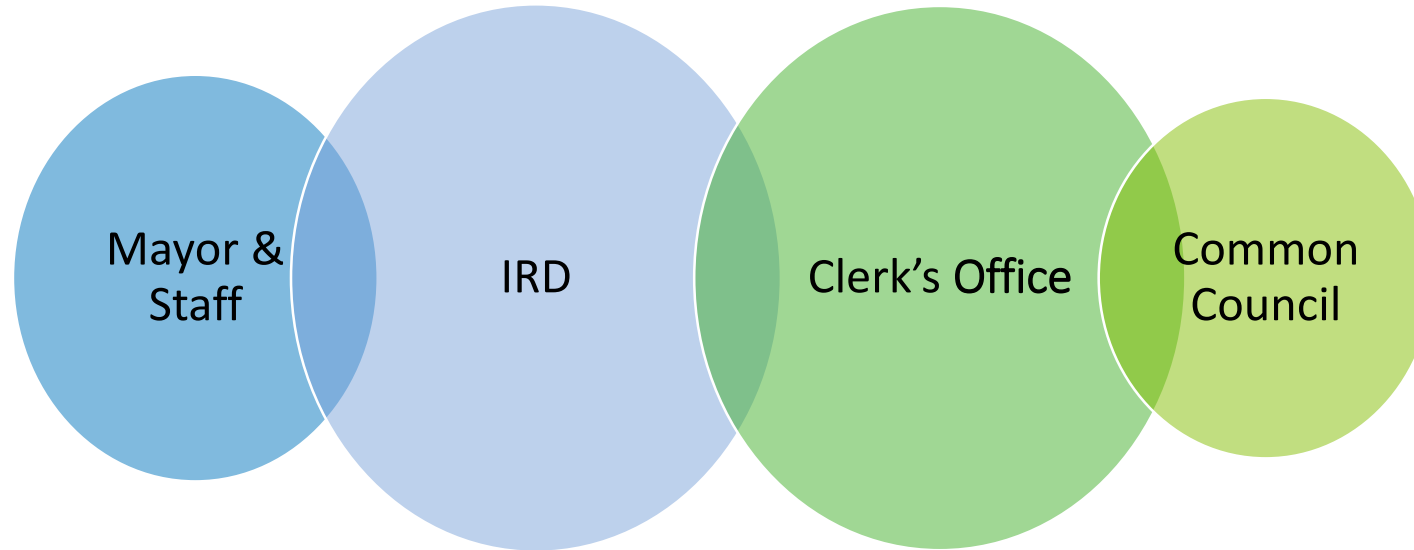
STATE LEGISLATIVE PACKAGE

AKA THE LEG PACKAGE

- Establishes city's legislative priorities
- Authorizes and provides city's lobbyists with a roadmap
- Monitored by the Judiciary and Legislation Committee
- Contains
 - Narrative section - broad
 - Detailed section - specific proposals
- Separate resolution for additions

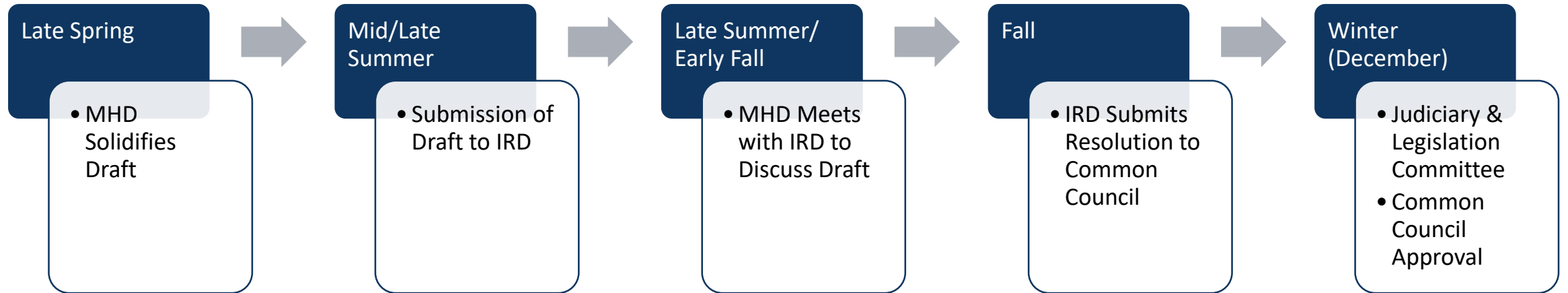

25-26 PRIORITIES

NARRATIVE SECTION

- Fiscal Capacity & Operational Efficiency
- Infrastructure, Transportation, and Environmental Sustainability
- Local Governance and Regulatory Flexibility
- Public Safety and Crime Prevention
- Racial, Social, and Economic Equity

MATERNAL & CHILD HEALTH

- Medicaid reimbursement for doula services
- Medicaid expansion: based on income and postpartum care for 12 months
- Abortion access
- Infant mortality rates
 - Diversifying the perinatal workforce
- Funding to DCF for home visiting programs

BUILT ENVIRONMENT

- Require all children <6 years of age who are in daycare and in school to have a current lead test on record
- Repeal the rental inspection preemption provisions of Act 176 Section 8 and Act 317
- Funding for green space and green infrastructure
- Funding for student nutrition programs, such as Farm to School and Healthy School Meals for All

SAFE & SUPPORTIVE COMMUNITIES

- Funding to address community mental health needs resulting from exposure to violent trauma
- Revise 895.48 (Good Samaritan Law) to include immunity for individuals experiencing overdose from parole/probation revocation and from criminal prosecution/arrest for distribution and paraphernalia.
- Funding for early childhood mental health consultation through school-based support and home visiting
- Oppose legislation that weakens gun safety restrictions
- Expansion of restorative justice programs

OPERATIONS

- Secure state funding for a high-priority Biosafety level-3 laboratory at the Milwaukee Health Department
