As part of a continuing plan to convert one-hour meter parking to two-hour meter parking, we are introducing Metered Parking Time Restriction changes within your district. We are recommending the following changes:

The removal of:

“One-Hour Meter Parking, 8 AM to 6 PM Monday – Friday, One-Hour Parking 8 AM to 6 PM Saturday” at the locations listed below:

The north side of West Michigan Street from North James Lovell Street to North 8th Street
The west side of North James Lovell Street from West Michigan Street to West Wisconsin Avenue

The installation of:

“Two-Hour Meter Parking, 8 AM to 6 PM Monday – Friday, Two Hour Parking, 8 AM to 6 PM Saturday”, One-Dollar per Hour at the locations listed below:

The north side of West Michigan Street from North James Lovell Street to North 8th Street
The west side of North James Lovell Street from West Michigan Street to West Wisconsin Avenue

The removal of:

“No Stopping 7 AM – 9 AM except Saturday and Sunday, One-Hour Meter Parking, 9 AM to 6 PM Monday – Friday, One-Hour Parking 8 AM to 6 PM Saturday” at the locations listed below:

The south side of West Wells Street from North 6th Street to North James Lovell Street
The south side of West Wells Street from North 8th Street to North 9th Street


The installation of:


Dear Alderman Henningsen:






