call for service regarding a group of vehicles gathering in the alley behind 817 W National Av and “people partying”. That following Monday, June 12, 2023, an email was forwarded to District 2’s email address from Alderman Perez’s office regarding a constituent/neighbor of 817 W National Av expressing their concern and frustration with people parking and partying in the SITE Staffing parking lot and behind the alley. The complainant stated, *“Friday night around 8pm I came back to our lot to pick up my car and our lot was filled with about 8-10 cars that did not belong to our employees. But the alley was in full party mode. Most people with cups, cans, bottles and many small children running around. Cars also parked up and down the sides of the alley.”*

I met with Mr. MARTINEZ on Tuesday, June 27, 2023, at 725 S 1st St for his CPTED survey regarding his application for a license at the location. During that meeting I advised Mr. MARTINEZ about the complaint regarding the parties and parking troubles in the alley associated with the bar behind his barbershop. Mr. MARTINEZ acknowledged the event and stated that he will prevent problems like that going forward if/when he has future.
