Dear Honorable Members:

Returned herewith is Common Council Resolution File Number 050121, being a petition from Caffeine Factory, LLC for a special privilege to keep and maintain three moveable planters in the public right-of-way of North 5<sup>th</sup> Street for the building at 422 North 5<sup>th</sup> Street.

The applicant is requesting permission to keep and maintain three moveable planters in the east, 15-foot wide sidewalk area to beautify the area in front of its building. Said planters are all 4 feet long, 1 foot wide and 2 feet 6 inches tall and project approximately 1 foot 2 inches into the public right-of-way. The planters are centered approximately 10, 19 and 35 feet south of the southline of the east-west alley in the block bounded by West Clybourn Street, West St. Paul Avenue, North 4<sup>th</sup> Street and North 5<sup>th</sup> Street.

A site visit revealed the main entrance to the building at 422 North 5<sup>th</sup> Street has an excess door swing projection that, when fully open, projects 3 feet into sidewalk area of North 5<sup>th</sup> Street, which is in excess of the 12 inches allowed per Sec. 245-4-8 of City of Milwaukee Code of Ordinances. Said door swing is centered approximately 27 feet south of the southline of the east-west alley in the block bounded by West Clybourn Street, West St. Paul Avenue, North 4<sup>th</sup> Street and North 5<sup>th</sup> Street.

We are not aware that said planters and excess door swing projection has had an adverse effect on the general use of the public right-of-way. We have, therefore, prepared the attached special privilege resolution, which, if adopted, will allow said planters and excess door swing to continue to occupy the public right-of-way.
