00002 1 PROCEEDINGS 2 CHAIRMAN WITKOWIAK: In the 12th 3 District, Rogelio Mercado Sanchez, Class "B" 4 Tavern application for "Taco Riendo" at 1631 West 5 Mitchell Street. And I just want - -6 ALDERMAN BOHL: Mr. Chairman. 7 CHAIRMAN WITKOWIAK: First, I want to 8 ask is there anyone here to testify on that 1631 9 West Mitchell? Okay. We're going to have the 10 - - Come to the table, please. We're going to 11 end up doing the same thing with this one, 12 because right - - when - - after we got this 13 thing, I'm not actually sure how this got on the 14 schedule, but we got some concerns and complaints 15 from people, and we're going to have to do the 16 same thing with this thing, hold it and have a 17 meeting and continue from there. 18 But - - But, sir, you're here. We want 19 to hear - - Identify - - Raise your right hand, 20 so we can swear you in. 21 (Whereupon the witness was sworn.) 22 THE WITNESS: I do. 23 CHAIRMAN WITKOWIAK: Name and address 24 for the record, please. 25 THE WITNESS: My name is Gregory West.

00003 I live at 1625 South 17th Street. 1 2 CHAIRMAN WITKOWIAK: And your 3 testimony, Mr. West. 4 THE WITNESS: Okay. First of all, I 5 would like to state that I'm here on another 6 matter, and I didn't even know about this. And -7 - until I looked at your agenda. And I've lived where I live for 30 - - over 31 years, and for 8 9 every - - Now, that - - I know that bar as the 10 Old Knotty Pine - -11 CHAIRMAN WITKOWIAK: Old Knotty Pine. 12 THE WITNESS: - - from way back when, 13 you know. But for every license application, I've always received notice of it. And like I 14 15 said, I had to find out. I live three-quarters 16 of a block away from that establishment. 17 CHAIRMAN WITKOWIAK: Something went 18 wrong with this one, also. So that's - - And I 19 got some phone calls yesterday, and I said we're 20 not - - I - - I'm not comfortable proceeding with 21 it, so. 22 THE WITNESS: Okay. 23 CHAIRMAN WITKOWIAK: But I - - But I 24 want to hear your testimony. And then we'll - -25 But we'll be scheduling it in September.

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2	THE WITNESS: Thank you. I, in fact, I
3	didn't even know anything new was going in. They
4	did put a paint job on it. But yesterday there
5	had to be 20 people standing out there last night
6	when I drove to park my car. First of all, I
7	would like clarification as to what this
8	establishment actually is going to be. Whether
9	it's going to be a bar or a restaurant?
10	CHAIRMAN WITKOWIAK: Supposedly, it's a
11	restaurant.
12	THE WITNESS: Okay. Well, we know how
13	that
14	CHAIRMAN WITKOWIAK: I know how that
15	goes.
16	THE WITNESS: how that goes, right.
17	CHAIRMAN WITKOWIAK: We just We
18	were just talking about that.
19	THE WITNESS: And I do live, let's say,
20	that like I said, three-quarters of a block
21	away, and a few patrons ago there, I mean,
22	establishment owners ago, there was there was
23	a bar in there that had big problems with this
24	bar. Mainly, because because he park
25	There is You know, Mitchell Street, that's
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1	all business there, and there is very little
2	parking. And so they come down 17th Street and
3	load it up. And I've had problems with beer
4	bottles, and the such. Late night, you know, the
5	weekends, especially, there is, you know, there
6	are people coming back to their to their
7	cars, and they're loud, and they're playing the
8	music. They stay there for a while, and then
9	they go.
10	So, I would really like the
11	clarification on this, and if there's going to be
12	another – – another hearing, I would like to be
13	notified.
14	CHAIRMAN WITKOWIAK: Yes, it is my hope
15	that the that we will hear this on September
16	11th, and in the meantime I think we should have
17	a neighborhood meeting.
18	THE WITNESS: Yeah, we can do
19	CHAIRMAN WITKOWIAK: Perhaps at the
20	location, and the owner can do the show and tell
21	over there.
22	THE WITNESS: Right.
23	CHAIRMAN WITKOWIAK: I think that would
24	be appropriate.
25	THE WITNESS: One of my concerns is we

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1	do have We do have another bar on the other
2	end, right on 17th Street, Pearl and Lapham.
3	CHAIRMAN WITKOWIAK: Right.
4	THE WITNESS: And now that bar we've
5	had There was a shooting there last year.
6	There was The bar was actually closed down
7	for a while, but now it's reopened. And still
8	we're getting the problem there with the people
9	leaving at night, and especially on the weekends.
10	Well, they are closed That's limited. You
11	know, limited as to when they're open, their
12	hours of operation. But still, you got the
13	weekends, and that's where you get a lot of that
14	problems. So, that's basically my main concern
15	for this one. I've got other testimony that
16	corresponds with this about it, the real reason
17	I'm here. So that's what I'd like to say for
18	now.
19	CHAIRMAN WITKOWIAK: Thank you, Mr.
20	West.
21	THE WITNESS: Thank you for hearing me.
22	CHAIRMAN WITKOWIAK: Okay. Mr.
23	Chairman, I move that we hold this matter at the
